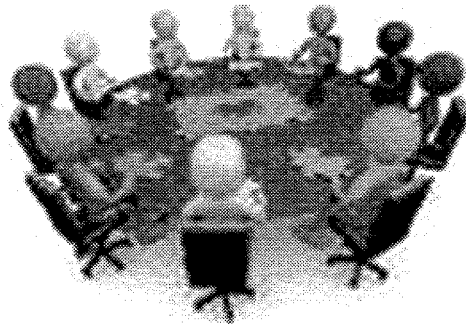



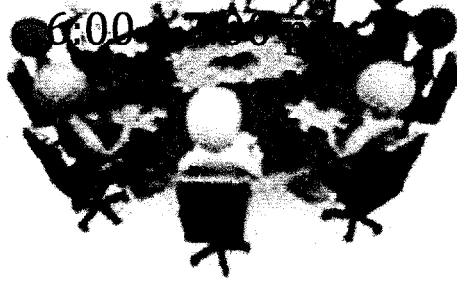

- **Welcome/Introduction** **Mr. Foster/ Ms. Scott**
- **Review/Approve December Minutes:**
Ms. Scott motion to approve December minutes and Mrs. Genius 2nded it.
- **Remarks- Mrs. Pitter:**
Mrs. Pitter welcomed everyone and reminded them to invite a friend. She also requested that the \$7,000 (5% +A funding) be allocated for the ELO camp for students in grades 3 through 5. This proposal was approved with a unanimous vote by the SAC committee members.
- **Literacy Week- Ms. Clarke:**
Ms. Clarke reviewed the importance of student participation for Literacy Week. She gave everyone a handout that gave a description of what students should wear for each day in recognition of the of this district initiative. She also reminded parents that in conjunction to Literacy week, Several community workers and various male leaders will come out the school on January 28th, for “Real Men Read”. Each reader will target grades 3-5.
- **Kindergarten Round Up- Ms. Clarke:**

Ms. Clarke encouraged parents to inform any parent that they know who has a child entering Kindergarten for 2026-27, to come out to learn what to expect in kindergarten and how they can enroll their child. A school-wide Class DOJO message was sent out and a robo -call was also sent out. This will be an evening event and refreshments will be provided.

▪ **ELO (tutoring)- Ms. Clarke:**

Ms. Clarke reminded parents that tutoring for grades 3-5 will begin on Monday, January 26th. Starting time will be from 2:15 – 4:15. She stated that we still had openings and if they were interested, to please fill out the application and turn it in to their child’s teacher.

▪ **School Safety- Mrs. Pitter**

Mrs. Pitter reminded parents of the importance of school safety. She explained that threats can not only be physical, but verbal as well. She directed parents to speak to their child and to encourage them to refrain from using threatening words to another student as well as to remember to follow the motto;” **If You See Something, Say Something.** “
