

- **Welcome/Introduction** **Mr. Foster**
The meeting began with Mr. Foster welcoming the parents and allowing them a few minutes to review the meeting minutes from our March meeting.
- **Review/Approve March Minutes-** March minutes were reviewed by all in attendance and approved & seconded by Mrs. Wilson (parent) and Mrs. Harvard (parent), respectively.
- **Test Preparation/ Updates**
Mrs. Pitter reminded the parents that we are officially in our PM3 assessment season. At this point the PM3 FAST ELA assessment has been administered to our primary grades. She stressed the importance of ensuring that all students receive a full night's sleep and a hearty breakfast, especially on testing mornings. Our intermediate grades are still in crunch time. Teachers and instructional Coaches are working closely together to close learning gaps and review testing strategies and best practices.

School Environment Safety Incident Report (SESIR):
Mrs. Pitter spoke about safety being our number 1 priority. She informed the parents that work is currently being performed to improve our security

measures as it relates to lock down procedures. Previously, the PA system could only be heard within rooms and classrooms, but now speakers are now being installed in the hallways, as well as other audio-visual updates.
