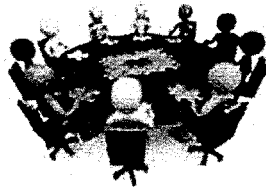

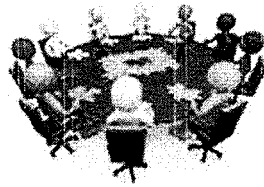

Mr. Foster explained that the School **Advisory Council (SAC)** is a formal body of parents, teachers, and other stakeholders that makes decisions regarding the School Improvement Plan (SIP), sets priorities, and monitors budget allocations to improve student achievement.

He also defined that the **School Advisory Forum (SAF)** is an open community forum for broader communication and advocacy, where concerns are addressed, community resources are identified, and parent/community programs are planned. SAF acts as a bridge to the SAC and the district, with a parent-chair and a representative to the Area Advisory.

School Environment Safety Incident Report (SESIR):

Ms. Rhodes-Hurley (AP)- presented on school safety. She shared that within the 1st 10 days of school, we had 2 fire drills, 1 lockdown drill, and 1 tornado drill (as required). She spoke about Behavior Threat Assessments (BTA) and the goal for us to not have any BTA occurrences. She educated the parents that any type of weaponry, toys that resemble weapons, threatening gestures/pictures could result in a BTA, which stays on the student's record all the way through high school.
