- **Welcome/Introduction** **Mr. Foster/ Ms. Scott**
- **Review/Approve October Minutes:**  
Mr. Foster distributed October minutes and instructed the parents to review/read silently. Mrs. Harvard approved the minutes and Ms. Scott 2<sup>nd</sup> it.
- **Florida School Recognition Program (A+ Funds) Proposals-  
Mr. Foster and Ms. Scott:**  
Mr. Foster thanked all stakeholders and SAC members for coming and how important their input is for creating a Florida School Recognition Program Ballot. He noted that this is our 1<sup>st</sup> time being awarded an “A”. He then reviewed the ballot from last year and clarified that based on Statewide changes, **A+ Funding cannot be used for student incentives and can only be used for educational equipment and materials.**
  - He then presented the total amount awarded by the state:  
**\$42,384(\$3760/8.7% ducted for fringe).**  
He also informed members that we still have a remaining balance of **\$7224 from 2023-24 school year for nonrecurring expenditures for educational equipment.**
  - The floor was then open for suggested ballot options. The following options were recorded for ballot options:

### **Option 1:**

- **5%** of the funds will go to the school **to be used for nonrecurring expenditures for educational equipment and materials.**
- **95%** of the funds will be used for a **one-time bonus to be divided** amongst all faculty and staff on the 2024-2025 Roster: to include interim subs. Staff must have worked at least 99 days of the 2024-2025 school year.

### **Option 2:**

- **15%** of the funds will go to the school **to be used for nonrecurring expenditures for educational equipment and materials.**
- **85%** of the funds will be used for a **one-time bonus to be divided** amongst all faculty and staff on the 2024-2025 Roster: to include interim subs. Staff must have worked at least 99 days of 2024-2025 school year.
- **“None of the above”,** was documented as the **3<sup>rd</sup> option.**

#### ▪ **School Safety- Mrs. Hurley:**

##### **School Environment Safety Incident Report (SESIR):**

Mrs. Hurley reviewed over the behavior matrix and discussed how important it is for parents to speak with their children about what they say to others, what they do, and objects they bring to school. She emphasized that Behavior Threat referrals become a part of a student’s cumulative school record. She also addressed that right before long breaks, Behavior Threat referrals increase significantly. She reminded parents that a behavior assembly is forthcoming where rules and procedures will be re-addressed.

#### • **Principals Message Mrs. Pitter:**

Mrs. Pitter thanked all members for their input and encouraged each member to continue to support SAC/PTO meetings. She then reviewed the upcoming events.
