Call to order, Introductions, Attendance: The meeting was called to order by Darren Stokes, at 11:44am and self-introductions were made.

Old Business:

Approval of Minutes: A motion to approve the minutes from November 19, 2025, was made by Shanti Golden, and seconded by Yvette Familia; motion carried.

New Business:

Director's Report: Cara Daniel

- **SkillsUSA:** Sheridan Technical College & Technical High School students earned 28 medals.
- **School Accountability Funds:** Our current balance is \$16,165.88.
 - Spend \$6,872.00 of the school accountability fund for Industry Certification exams and training material for Practical Nursing students. A motion was made by Nicole Alexander and seconded by Robert Decker; motion carried.
- **BCPS News:** Due to declining student enrollment, the district made the decision to close 6 schools.
- **Campus Updates:**
 - **A+ School Recognition Funds:** Faculty & Staff voted, passed with 82%. Ballot 1- 100% of A+ funds are to be equally distributed among all contracted Sheridan Faculty and staff that were employed during the entire 2024-2025 school year. The total amount that was awarded was \$45,723.
 - **Mid-Year Performance Metrics:** US History EOC – 98%, Geometry EOC – 72%, Algebra I – 42%, Biology EOC – 76%, FAST PM2 ELA Reading 9th Grade – 84% and 10th Grade – 79%
- **Main Campus Construction:** The Main Campus is undergoing several significant Building Envelope Improvements as part of the SMART Bond Program.

SIP Monitoring and Stakeholder Feedback & High School Report: Wendolynn Mola

- Our structured tutoring program, offered three times weekly for all EOC and AP courses, has contributed to improved scores. We are using Varsity Tutors for high-dosage Algebra One tutoring, with sessions occurring twice a week during electives, with diagnostic data showing an average gain of 200%.
- The three Broward Technical Colleges are working together on a common pacing guide which will standardize instruction and assessment across campuses, including non-EOC/AP English honors classes.
- School Board Member Ms. Leonardi is leading diverse student focus groups to inform decisions and increase engagement, she will meet with students on January 23, 2026.

Council of Occupational Education (COE): Mary Barba

- The Annual Report has been submitted and is currently under review. Departments are preparing for their Spring Advisories, and teachers are in the process of submitting their Industry Visitation reports.

Assistant Director Reports:

Mary Barba reported that three high school students were chosen to attend the CTE Scholars Banquet on April 2nd, 2026. The Cosmetology department has 168 students, AGE has over 300 students, Culinary has 43, and Surge Tech has just under 40 students.

Barrett Goldman reported that all his programs are full, and there are waitlists as long as one year for certain programs.

Jose Laverde shared that pharmacy tech students will soon begin clinicals, PCT and Nursing students are graduating soon, IT now includes fiberoptics in its programs, and ESOL enrollment remains steady.

Safety and Security/SESIR (School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting): Jose Laverde

- Reminder of the importance of our CENTEGIX badges. It provides an extra layer of security across our campus. There have been no SESIR incidents since last meeting.

Student Reports:

Class of 2026: Aniyah Smith reported that the class of 2026 is excited to host STHS' first Spring Fling dance, themed "It's A 90s Thing", on Thursday, March 12th from 6-10pm.

Class of 2029: Tahrat Shaira reported that the class of 2029 is currently holding an election for historian. In addition to elections, they are also planning our first popcorn fundraiser.
