Call to order, Introductions, Attendance: The meeting was called to order by Darren Stokes, at 11:40am and self-introductions were made.

Old Business:

Approval of Minutes: A motion to approve the minutes from September 24, 2025, was made by Yvette Familia, and seconded by Juliana Esguerra; motion carried.

New Business:

Director's Report: Cara Daniel

- **CTE Teacher of the Year:** Chef Brian is recognized for 2025–2026 by the district CTACE Department.
- **VITA Grant Award:** We received a \$10,000 IRS grant for our Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program, which offers free tax prep to students, staff, and the community.
- **School Accountability Funds:** Current balance is \$21,345.88. SAC committee approved \$10,000 for HS tutoring (Math, Science, Social Studies, AP), leaving \$11,345.88.
- **Redefining Our Schools:** The district is collecting feedback about redefining several BCPS schools. Technical College plans to expand CTE PS Programming.
- **Main Campus Construction:** Ongoing SMART Bond upgrades include roof, window, and wall repairs; new restroom in Building 12; electrical, fire alarm, sprinkler, HVAC improvements; and media center enhancements.
- **Florida School Recognition A+:** As an A-Rated high school, we will receive \$45,723 from the state for our rating.

SIP Monitoring and Stakeholder Feedback & High School Report: Wendolynn Mola

- Ms. Mola outlined support measures for upcoming tests, including after-school and Saturday tutoring, literacy coaching, pull-out sessions, and use of the Varsity Tutor platform for FAST ELA PM2, Algebra and Geometry EOC, PSAT, and SAT preparation.

Council of Occupational Education (COE): Mary Barba

- Ms. Barba identified the six programs that are slated for improvement for next year.

Assistant Director Reports:

Mary Barba reported that Cosmetology, Barbering, Nails, and Facials programs are at capacity. Office of Student Affairs is getting ready for the new registration period.

Barrett Goldman reported that the School Board approved our CBD contract that will allow us to do specialized trainings. Out of eighteen business students who took the ESB exam, 87% passed.

Jose Laverde reported that the ESOL Program is having their annual Pie Party today to commemorate Thanksgiving.

Florida School Recognition Program (A+) Proposals and Ballot Creation:

- Ms. Daniel outlined the guidelines for the A+ Proposal and Ballot Creation process. A list of the proposals submitted by staff were discussed.
- The following motions were made:
 - Motion #1 made by Nicole Alexander and seconded by Renea Kraus was to select the following proposal to be submitted to the faculty and staff for a vote along with the required “none of the above”:
 1. 100% of A+ funds are to be equally distributed among ALL contracted Sheridan Faculty and staff that were employed during the entire 2024-2025 school year.
 - A roll call vote was held, motion passed unanimously.
 - Motion #2 made by Yvette Familia and seconded by Nicole Rowntree was to select the following two proposals to be submitted to the faculty and staff for a vote along with the required “none of the above”:
 1. 100% of A+ funds are to be equally distributed among ALL contracted Sheridan Faculty and staff that were employed during the entire 2024-2025 school year.
 2. 50% of the funds will be distributed to all the 2024-2025 high school full time faculty and staff, including the AM and PM CDE teachers that teach Sheridan Technical High School students and the technology staff.
