- Discussion of A+ Proposals- Presentation by Mr. Schroeder

Mrs. Mills reviewed the purpose of the School Recognition Funds and why we received the money. Mr. Schroeder gave more information on the amount of money that we have received. We have approximately \$74,000. He mentioned that last year we received \$109,000 and this year they reduced the amount of money that we received. We reviewed historically what we have proposed the money to be used for. Mrs. Dominique made a proposal to have \$10,000 of the funds to be used for enrichment/remediation camps for the students of Margate Elementary and distribute the remaining funds equally amongst the staff of the 2024-2025 school year, who were employed for at least 99 days of the school year and in good standing. The motion was approved by Lisa Gruver and seconded by Nicole Browne. The motion was passed unanimously. There was rich conversation about whether we will have enough money for the camps if we don't include the \$10,000 would we be able to keep our grade. Mr. Schroeder shared that he is confident that we will be focusing in meeting the needs of all students during the school day and we will find a way to have some form of a camp for students after school.

Mrs. Roberts asked for a proposal to be made for 100% of the funds to be distributed equally amongst the staff of the 2024-2025 school year, who were employed at least 99 days and in good standing. The motion was approved by Keshia Roberts and seconded by Venus Dellatorre. The motion was passed unanimously. Once again we had rich conversation about all the hard work that our teachers do on a daily basis

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and using the recognition funds to reward them for all their hard work. 12.5.2016






