I. Welcome/Introduction

Ms. Pompy welcomed attendees to the SAC meeting. She called the meeting to order at 2:35 am. Quorum was met for to proceed as a business meeting.

II. Review of Agenda/Minutes

Attendees reviewed the agenda and the meeting minutes from the month of December. The meeting minutes were approved.

III. School Consolidation (Redefining Schools)

Ms. Dorsett shared that Sunshine Elementary and Fairway Elementary will merge into one school for the upcoming school year. This change was officially confirmed and approved by the School Board and Superintendent on January 21, 2026. A community meeting is scheduled for February 4, 2026, at Sunshine Elementary, where parents and guardians will have the opportunity to ask questions regarding the transition. District personnel will be onsite to address any concerns.

IV. Data Review and Analysis

Ms. Dorsett reviewed Sunshine Elementary's leading data, including FAST PM2 results. This data was used to identify instructional gaps and activate targeted interventions aimed at improving student achievement.

V. Title One Updates

Ms. Dorsett shared the Customer Survey results with the attendees and explained the purpose of the survey, emphasizing how the feedback is used to drive improvements in areas of need. She also shared that the survey results would be emailed to all council members for further, more in-depth review, if desired.

VI. School-Wide Initiatives and Programs

Ms. Dorsett emphasized the importance of parental involvement in supporting students' academic growth and overall educational success. Parents and guardians were encouraged to attend scheduled conferences with their child's teacher to remain informed and actively engaged in their child's progress.

Enrichment Learning Opportunity Camps are currently operating for invited students. Phase I tutoring concluded on January 27, 2026, and focused on providing intensive remediation for Level 1 students. Phase II tutoring will begin on February 2 and continue through April. These efforts support our ongoing goal of earning an "A" school grade.

VII. SAC Accountability Funds

Ms. Dorsett discussed the purpose of accountability funds and how the funds assist our school. We currently have \$26,385.00 in accountability funds as of the month of January.

The council previously discussed the allocation of SAC Accountability Funds and had approved a request for fence covering around the school's perimeter. However, this request has been canceled due to Sunshine Elementary's consolidation with Fairway Elementary for the 2026–2027 school year.

Ms. Dorsett requested funding in the amount of \$6,000 for instructional materials and \$19,000 for student incentives, incentive machines, and student field trips. The proposed use of funds will increase the availability of instructional materials as supplemental resources to support remediation and reteaching efforts. Student incentives were noted as impactful in promoting positive student performance outcomes. The council voted on and approved the funding request.

VIII. School Environment Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR)

Ms. Pompey explained to council members the purpose of SESIR and how schools track incidents and analyze patterns of violent, criminal, or disruptive activity. The intent is for there to be complete and objective data from which to design interventions to improve the learning environment. Sunshine Elementary has no SESIR incidents currently.

IX. Principal's Report

FAST PM2 testing has concluded, and Math has increased 20% and Reading increased by 18%. We are still being intentional in our work.
