## ELO Camps Implementation Plan

We propose to begin our Extended Learning Opportunity (ELO) Camps in February and continue through April, offering a total of eight sessions. The camps will focus on three key academic areas: Science for 5th grade, English Language Arts (ELA) for 3rd through 5th grades, and Math for 4th and 5th grades.

To successfully launch and operate these ELO Camps, we are requesting \$3,000 in funding support. These funds will be utilized to cover the essential expenses required to implement and maintain the quality of the camps throughout the designated period.


