










Safety and Security Operations

- Safety and Security employs approximately 800 staff members across various roles.
- Safety technology, specifically the Raptor system, requires all visitors, volunteers, and contractors to check in; the system flags sexual predators, and established procedures are followed if someone is flagged.
- Subcontractors are fingerprinted as part of the security protocol.
- Campus monitors, an entry-level position, are present in schools to observe and report; some schools also have Security Specialists, often retired law enforcement, who are able to handle more advanced security tasks.
- School Resource Officers (SROs) are stationed on campuses full-time.
- Due to a hiring freeze, there has been a reduction in staff as departing employees are not replaced.
- All perimeter and classroom doors remain locked at all times for enhanced safety.
- There are plans to upgrade the PA system in high schools, including integration with smoke detectors.
- There is ongoing discussion about shifting from SROs to guardians for school security.
- Every employee and substitute is issued a Centegix badge to wear on campus, which can be used during medical emergencies or lockdowns.
- Since August, there have been 4,403 alerts generated by the badge system, including some accidental lockdowns.
