






- ❖ Broward County Public Schools is divided into three regional offices—North, Central, and South—plus a School Transformation Office. offer leadership coaching and support to the schools within their regions.
- ❖ Each office is led by a Regional or Assistant Superintendent, supported by Teaching and Learning Directors, instructional facilitators, and other staff, all working to ensure schools meet educational standards.
- ❖ Parents should contact their school first then the regional office for support
- ❖ School Transformation Office – Support lower performing schools.

### **Federal Programs Department (Title I)**

- ❖ There are still grants available
- ❖ Title I schools consist of not only Public but Charter (46) and Private (69) schools as well
- ❖ They sponsor Community Events, for example Stem Fest, Joy of Poetry, and Father & Daughter Dance which anyone can attend
