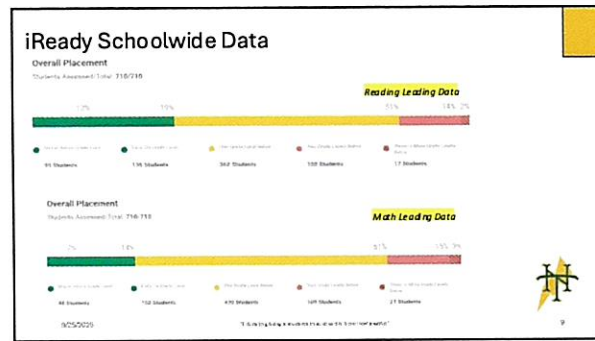

### I. Welcome & Introduction/Meeting Etiquette

II. Approved Meeting Minutes from August's SAC Meeting. Mrs. Olavarria approved the minutes and Ameide Jacques second the motion.

III. **Mr. Schwartz Report:** There were No SESSIR incidents to report. Thanked the PTA for all their hard work and getting grandparents day and Dads & Donuts Day both events were a HUGE success with an incredible turnout. He also reviewed the calendar that there will be No School on October 3, and possibly an Early Release Day on October 10<sup>th</sup>. Book Fair will begin October 6<sup>th</sup> and there is an upcoming iZone Meeting October 17<sup>th</sup> @ 10 a.m. at Nova High School. **SMART Bond Updates:** All AC Units have been installed they have also laid new grass. Parking and the new bus area are working well. The contractors will be moving to Eisenhower to begin their renovations as well. Staff updates we had to lose a teacher because of our numbers. Viera who was hired to be the ESE Support Facilitator is now a third Grade Teacher Ms. Appleman's 1<sup>st</sup> grade class has been dismantled and distributed among the first-grade classes. **ESE Updates:** Ms. Rice is now our Intern ESE Specialist in the absence of Mrs. Raymond. We recently had a Tech Audit, and we are still unable to locate an old printer from 2003. **FAST PM1 Updates:** Overall in ELA we had 34% proficiency and 17% proficiency in Math both these scores are up from last school year. **ELA by Grade Level:** 3<sup>rd</sup>: 33 to 30, 4<sup>th</sup> 31 to 40 5<sup>th</sup> 30-32. **Math by Grade Level:** 3<sup>rd</sup> 18 to 16 4<sup>th</sup> 14 to 19 and 5<sup>th</sup> 22-17.

IV. **School Improvement Plan:** Mrs. Daniel-Kalio talked about helping the stakeholders that our goal this year is to help increase performance in the lowest quartile in both reading and math. We are also striving to increase Science proficiency in science as well.

**V. SAC Composition Voting:** SAC Composition was presented in SAC Mrs. Noelle Corris made the first motion to approve the SAC Composition and Mrs. Juliana Evangeliste second the motion.

**VI. Title I Addendum:** Used for extra support such as Science Coach Math Coach and the Science STEM Teacher SAC was also asked if they wanted to add to the Addendum

**VII. Accountability Funds:** Money has not yet been transferred into our account but our current balance of \$7,203.00

**VIII. Parent Questions and Concerns:**

- a.** Car line concerns: Parents asked Mr. Schwartz about how we can make the car line run more smoothly. Mr. Schwartz asked for suggestions
- b.** Parent asked about how they can get more information about to get information for PTA and the PTA President talked about how they could get information by simply joining the PTA
- c.** 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Parent asked why 5<sup>th</sup> grade was not allowed to play on the playground. Mr. Schwartz answered and said he would talk to the 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Team
- d.** Parents also asked about getting a sunshade for the playground and asked about wanting to have a Sun Safety Program so they can apply for a grant to get a cover for the playground
