REMINDER: Once again, School Recognition Funds (A+ Money) are being distributed to schools by the state based on school grades. **Because McFatter maintained its "A" rating (YAY!!!)**, we will be receiving funds. As required, the SAC came up with a proposal at its last meeting that contracted staff need to vote on. It is pasted below and attached. 

