##### Magnet Program & Enrollment

- Showcase and Open House were successful.
- 286 applications received; 172 eligible.
- Random selection scheduled for January 19.
- 10th graders to complete tech selection by January 10.

##### Testing & Academic Updates

- EOC retakes underway; attendance strong.
- PM2 Reading scores increased (9th +3, 10th +1).

##### District Enrollment Declines & Hiring Freeze

- Workforce programs allowed to continue hiring.
- Overtime reductions required due to long operating hours.
- High school enrollment expected to fill all available seats.

##### District Restructuring

- District planning closure of seven schools.
- Early intention forms sent to administrators.
- Superintendent intends to minimize layoffs.

##### Schools of Hope Update

- McFatter mistakenly listed as a possible site due to data misinterpretation.
- District visit confirmed no available instructional space.

- McFatter removed from consideration.

#### Technical Program Expansion

- District exploring expansion west of I-75.

#### ESE Population Support

- Full-time ESE Specialist secured.
- Speech-Language Pathologist available via contractor.
- Commitment to ensuring students with disabilities receive full support.





