I. Welcome/Call to Order

- Mr. González called the meeting to order at 5:05pm.

II. Principal's Report

- Mr. Garranchan began his report letting the community know that the district had a hiring freeze throughout the entire county.
- He also stated that right now, everyone's position was secure and that he had no plans for letting anyone go.
- Mr. Garranchan also emphasized that if he had to let someone go, that the position would be illuminated.
- Enrollment was key and we needed to maintain our enrollment to make sure that he did not have to let anyone go.
- As of January '26, Nova Middle School was above student projection.
- The district, between the end of January or some time in February, would be handing out laptops to any student whose parents opted in for the free device.
- This was an initiative from the district to make sure that every student had an electronic device that they could do work and study from home.
- Nova's PM2 scores came out and we are at a good place to repeat our A+.
- Mr. Garranchan stated that Nova needed to, not only, to maintain our level 3's and above but that we also needed to move our learning gain points as well to keep pace.

III. New Business

- a. Read and approve minutes from last month
 - December's minutes were read and a motion was made by Ms. Buchanan and seconded by Mr. Garranchan. Minutes were approved unanimously.
- b. SIP Mid-year reflection

- Mr. González presented the Mid-year reflection including the parent allocation budget, SIP goals, FAST PM1 & PM2 results and our PM3 goals.
- He also presented what the ELA, Math, and Science departments were working on based off of the data and what teachers are doing in the classroom and during professional learning communities (PLC's) to help bring up the level gaps.
- Parent allocation budget for the '25-'26 school year is \$6,074, which goes towards student agendas, supplies for parents and students, and additional reading materials for parents to assist students.
- Nova's SIP goal is to at least go up by 3% from last year's 66% proficiency to 69%.
- For the second time, Nova Middle was not an ESSA school. **Every Student Succeeds Act.**
- The PM1 & PM2 results for ELA resulted in a 9.33% total increase throughout the three grade levels.
- The PM1 & PM2 results for Math resulted in an 8.33% total increase throughout the three grade levels.

- There was no SESIR report as the district still has not updated their website.

- Mr. Garranchan stated that at the moment, he was not looking to purchase any additional student materials.
