I. Welcome/Call to Order

- Mr. González called the meeting to order at 5:07pm.

II. Introduction

- Mr. González requested that the minutes from last month be read and approved
- A motion was made by Ms. Mondesir and seconded by Ms. Buchanan
- The minutes were approved by a unanimous vote.

III. Principal's Report

- Mr. Garranchan began his report with this week's PM2 state testing. Today was the 6th grade reading exam. Tomorrow will be the 6th grade math. On Thursday, the 7th & 8th graders will be taking the reading exam and on Friday they will be taking the math portion for the exception of the Algebra and Geometry students.
- Nova is striving to test at least 97% of the student population.
- Nova will also be having a "Why to Nova Tour". This tour will show parents and students why they would love to choose Nova as their next school.
- A weeks later, Nova will then have a "New to Nova Night" for parents and students who are coming up from the two elementary schools to see what Nova Middle School offers.

IV. New Business

- a. New ESOL Parent Vote
 - Nova's SAC found an ESOL parent, Ms. Natacha Sinvil, and a motion was made by Mr. Garranchan and seconded by Mrs. Hartmann de Barros to vote Ms. Sinvil to SAC. Ms. Sinvil became the ESOL parent designee with unanimous approval.
- b. SIP Plan
 - No update on with the SIP because this week Nova was administering the State PM2 reading and math exams.

- After the exams, the data will be disseminated and discussed in January during the Mid-year SIP report.

c. A+ Funds

SAC asked that only option 1 be put in the ballot and if option 1 does not pass with staff members, then in January SAC would put option 2 on the ballot for the staff members to vote on.
