**I. Welcome/Call to Order**

- SAC meeting called to order by Mr. Gonzalez at 5:03

**II. Principal's Report**

- We started the distribution of laptops for the students (103) in total.
- The student needs to take and bring back the devices every day.
- Before state testing begins, we will collect the laptops so the students can use them for testing.
- We don't have enough hardcases for the laptops, so unfortunately, some will break.
- We are going to try to fix the laptops under warranty but after the warranty, the parents will need to pay for it.
- We have some teachers that are being placed by the district, and we also have now an interim sub for Mr. Unger.
- There is still a hiring freeze in the district and some middle schools that have low enrollment will now become a 6-12 schools.
- We have 1289 students, at Nova, and we continue to lose enrollment. We started at 1400. We are 21 students above projected enrollment, so we are good.
- The moment we fall below our projected number, we might have to close programs and let go of teachers.
- District needs us to use the accountability funds before the district takes it for something else.
- We need computers for the front staff and the principals (desktops).
- Mini desktops for the camera room and front office \$440.18 each (times 3)
- Desktops for the office staff including Principal \$660.11 (times 4)

- Extra Math periods and ESE (504) periods that were taken away from the district  
\$2,100 + \$3,000
- Purchase Promethean boards including rolling stands \$2,593 (times 3).
- Grand total of \$18,160
- Accountability balance of \$19,347 minus \$18,160 will leave the accountability balance at \$1,187.
- The extra math pay will be going to the teacher who took over for Ms. Polikoff and to Ms. Renton-Murray who is the ESE coordinator.
- We can only use vendors approved by the district.
- We are also working very hard to work to keep and maintain our A+ status for the state FAST/BEST Testing.
- Writing will begin in April and then the entire month of May we will be testing Reading, Math, Science, & High School courses.
- We are reminding the students and parents regarding fighting in school and the consequences of fighting.

A motion was made to approve the funds by Ms. Garcia and a second by Novembre – The funds passed unanimous.

  - Mr. Gonzalez asked if the committee would like to recommend any changes for next year based on the data received from the survey and no one wanted to make changes or add additional information.
