I. Welcome/Call to Order

II. Principal's Report

- Writing test was done last week.
- The results have not come back and will not come back as fast as ELA and Math.
- Science is doing a review once a week after school.
- Math department will be doing a review during their planning hours every week.
- School Choice extended their application window. There is no close date for now.

III. New Business

- a. Read and approval last month's minutes
 - A motion was made to approve the minutes by Ms. Scott and seconded by Mr. Garranchan. The motion carried and last month's minutes were approved unanimously.
- b. Accountability Funds
 - Computers that the SAC members voted for and approved were denied by the district.

 - Nova's accountability funds are \$6,468.20
 - **Item #1:** Mr. Garranchan would like to purchase an additional Promethean Board at a cost of \$2,593.00
 - A motion was made by Ms. Buchanan and seconded by Mr. Garranchan to approve the purchase of the Promethean Board. The motion passed unanimously.

- A motion was made by Ms. Andre and seconded by Mrs. Hartmann de Barros.
- The motion passed unanimously.
- The final balance of Nova’s School Accountability Funds is now at \$0.
- c. School Wide Positive Behavior Plan – Presented by Mrs. Johnkins
 - Parents and community members were given time to look over the plan.
 - The members were satisfied with the plan and did not make any changes.
 - Mrs. Johnkins went over the top five infractions for Nova Middle.
 - We need to help make guidelines for the positive students.
 - Mrs. Johnkins ask the PTSA for help with any donations that were possible.
