I. Call to Order

The School Advisory Council (SAC) meeting was called to order at 8:38 AM by Ms. Stone.

II. Reading and Approval of Minutes

The committee reviewed the previous meeting minutes from November 18, 2025. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Ms. Stone and seconded by Ms. Ellis. The motion carried.

III. New Business

The committee discussed updates related to instructional supports, including small-group math interventions designed to address the needs of students identified under ESSA, ESE, and ELL.

IV. School Improvement Plan (SIP)

The committee discussed the mid-year reflection for the School Improvement Plan (SIP). The SIP is a living document that updates independently as data is entered and reviewed. The mid-year reflection is a required component and must be completed and submitted by February 1, 2026. Ongoing review of the SIP remains a priority.

VI. BTU Updates

There were no updates reported from the Broward Teachers Union (BTU).

VII. SAF Updates

School Advisory Forum (SAF) projects are progressing as planned. The sprinkler system installation has been completed. Bathroom renovations and fire alarm system improvements are currently underway, with completion expected by February.

VIII. Department Updates

ELA: The department reported a 3% increase compared to last year's PM2 results.

Math: The January PM2 assessment has concluded, and mid-year midterm assessments are underway.

Reading: i-Ready assessments are scheduled for January.

Literacy: Planning is underway for a Literacy Fair scheduled for February.

Guidance: Counselors are meeting with high school students to support the development of four-year academic plans. A list is also being created to identify eighth-grade students who may require recovery courses for promotion.

ESE: The department is developing a list of incentives for students who complete i-Ready assessments and demonstrate improvement in FAST scores.
