

 - a. The School Advisory Forum Chair called the meeting to order at 3:35 pm.

- II. North Area Advisory Council Updates
 - a. Student Services
 - i. Hazel Health through June 30, 2026
 - 1. Future plans in discussion
 - ii. School Psychological Services
 - 1. Each school has one psychologist
 - a. Works well for the larger district since every student doesn't require the services
 - b. Around 10-12 vacancies in the district.
 - 2. 2,910 District-wide psychological evaluations
 - 3. Currently completed 518 Pre-K assessments, 750 in progress
 - a. Broward does full screening in one day, so it is complete
 - 4. When request is made by a parent, 30 days to comply; other request vary from 30/60/90
 - 5. This office was complemented for efficiency
District Hiring Freeze
 - iii. Security Impacts
 - 1. No change to allocation
 - 2. Campus Monitors were full in October
 - 3. 40-50 openings now (entry level position)
 - iv. Middle School AP
 - 1. Currently all middle schools have 3 Aps
 - 2. Moving forward, schools under 700 will have 2 APs
SAC Funds
 - v. Accountability Funds
 - 1. FUNDS SHOULD BE SPENT
 - 2. FUNDS DO NOT ROLLOVER
 - 3. Around \$5.00 per student
 - 4. ***Extensive discussion about rolling over funds or spending funds. Motion made that Principals, SAC Chairs, and committee are informed about how much money needs to be spent.

 - 1. For Staff incentive and school purchases
