- I. ESE Advisory Chair
 - a. Discussed concerns with FOCUS documentation for ESE students
 - b. Discussed classroom camera access pro/con
 - c. ESE Advisory meetings are monthly on the 3rd Wednesday at Indian Ridge Middle from 6:15-8:45 pm

- II. FOCUS
 - a. BCPS Staff need an email address other than their work email to access.
 - b. Focus office needs to know if IMT isn't updating in a timely manner

- III. NURSES
 - a. 57 schools without nurses
 - b. At the start of school, 63 schools were without nurses
 - c. Some nurses have 15 schools
 - d. Nurses have to go through each health plan to create an emergency plan for kids with needs; no nurse means no plan
 - e. State Law calls for registered nurses, but clinical nurses can supervise unlicensed assistive personnel (UAP)
 - f. Staff are to be retrained on asthma, anaphylaxis, and diabetes
 - g. *A MOTION WAS MADE TO HAVE A NURSE IN EVERY SCHOOL*
 - h. *PARENTS NEED TO COMMUNICATE WITH SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS*

IV. LUNCH

- a. Lunches are free until September 19
- b. BCPS has entertained the idea of a courtesy meal instead of a cheese sandwich meal
- c. Push out Myschoolbucks info to families as much as the application

V. VAPE DETECTORS

- a. There is AI technology that can detect vaping or certain words (ex: "fight")
- b. Supposed to start at the middle school level
- c. On SESIR says tobacco, not vaping
- d. Discussion on possible motion to start technology at high schools

VI. SOCIAL MEDIA

- a. Make sure high school coaches are clear about what is posted on social media
- b. Coaches have asked kids to post on social media who were not of age to be on social media

VII. REDEFINING - carry to next mtg

- a. Awareness of students in potential middle school closures on how it will affect high schools (such as Coral Springs HS) that are already under-enrolled
- b. Studies show that it has negatively impacted students' social and educational well-being, and it is detrimental to a community. It's challenging for students to find that same sense of community at a new school.
