**Welcome, Introductions and Call to Order**

- The meeting was called to order at 3:10pm
- The SAC notes were reviewed and accepted. The motion was first approved by Girard and seconded by Forbes.

**Principal's Report**

- Mrs. Robinson congratulated Dr. Sannullah on being selected as the 2026 Teacher of the Year.
- Mrs. Robinson addressed the lockdown that occurred earlier in the day due to a reported threat in the area and noted that safety procedures were followed to ensure the protection of students and staff.
- Mrs. Robinson thanked Mrs. Sannon for stepping in to facilitate the January meeting in her absence.
- The Media Center will be open to students during both A and B lunch. Students must obtain a pass to attend. The Media Center will be closed on February 11 due to a scheduled JROTC inspection.

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- The principal discussed possible changes related to a potential school merger. One possible name that has been suggested is Central Broward Collegiate Academy; however, this is only under consideration and not finalized until SAC meets and goes through the process.
- Additional discussions included the possibility of housing middle school students in the 2500 building, exploring the implementation of uniforms, maintaining the current school start and end times, and potentially adjusting the schedule by approximately five minutes to support transitions if changes occur.

### **Old Business**

- Dr. Sannuallah shared that the school is still seeking an ESOL teacher, but there is a potential candidate for the Gifted position.
- The Library Media Plan is posted under the Media section of the school website. The plan is 22 pages and outlines the materials and resources included in the library collection. Dr. Sannuallah asked for a motion to approve the plan. Girard made the motion and Attah seconded it. The plan was approved.

### **New Business-**

- Dr. Sannuallah shared the latest SESIR data and reminded members that the data typically reflects a one-month lag.
- Dr. Sannuallah presented the idea of changing the school's name as part of the proposed merger to a 6-12 school. One possible name discussed was Central Broward Collegiate Academy 6-12.
- Dr. Sannuallah explained the role of SAC, emphasizing that SAC provides input and recommendations, but the final decision will be made by the School Board.
- Dr. Sannuallah also discussed the stakeholder feedback plan, including how feedback will be collected and the use of a ballot regarding the proposed school name change. The vote is expected to take place sometime in March or April, and the timeline was reviewed.
- Dr. Sannuallah asked for a motion to support rebranding the school's name, mascot, and logo. The motion was presented and approved during the meeting.
- The vote to support rebranding the school passed unanimously with a vote of 10-0.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:55pm and motioned to adjourned by Ms.Girard and second by Ms. Reed.
