- The meeting was called to order at 3:13 p.m.
- Dr. Sannullah instructed all participants to sign in
- Dr. Sanullah made a motion to approve the SAC minutes from the last SAC meeting, the motion accepted by Mrs. Robinson, second by Ms. Forbes all were in favor.

**Principal's Report**

- Principal Robinson discussed PM1 ELA data, noting it was neither strong nor weak, with no growth shown. She's hoping for improvement during PM2 on December 10th.

- Dr. Sanuallah distributed hard copies of the SAF and SAC bylaws and asked participants to take a moment to review them.
  - Mrs. Martin asked about advertising the open Gifted position through the Guidance Director for additional support; Dr. Sanuallah agreed to reach out to the Director.
  - Dr. Sanuallah reviewed attendance and explained that the group could not vote on the by-laws due to attendance requirements. Participants were instructed to review the bylaws and be prepared to vote at the next meeting on November 12th at 3:00 p.m. (rescheduled due to no school on November 11th).
  - When asked if there were any questions about the by-laws, Mrs. Martin revisited the topic of open parent representative positions and requested clarification on why both ESE and Gifted parent representatives were needed if they fall under the same umbrella. Dr. Sanuallah clarified that SAC requires a representative for each area.
  - Participants were then given SAF bylaws to review. Dr. Sanuallah asked if any questions; there were none. The Chair confirmed that SAF bylaws will also be voted on at the next meeting.
  - Mrs. Thropes (SAF Chair) asked Mrs. Forbes (SGA Advisor) about the safety of posting Homecoming times and locations on social media, noting that a student's extended family was able to view Homecoming Princess voting, raising privacy and safety concerns.
  - Principal Robinson stated she would investigate the matter and report back on proper safety protocols for clubs posting on social media.
