- Mrs. Sanaullah transitioned the meeting to begin the elections for the 2025–2026 school year.
- After her introduction, Mrs. Sanaullah turned the meeting over to Principal Robinson.
- Principal Robinson started the election process, clearly explaining the procedures and purpose of each role.
- The following results were recorded:
  - First, Mr. Sanuallah was nominated as Chairman and received 7 votes from the SAC members.
  - Next, Ms. Denaira Robinson was elected as Secretary with 7 votes.
  - Then, Ms. Tracey Shaw was elected as the Non-Instructional Representative, also receiving 7 votes.
  - At this time, there is no representative for Gifted, ESE, or ESOL, but these positions remain open, and we are looking to fulfill them.
  - After that, Mr. Richard Wallace was elected as the Community Representative with 6 votes.
  - Following, Mr. Nympha Girad was elected as the BTU Representative with 7 votes.
  - The Initiative Zone Representative position is currently open, and we are looking to fulfill it.
  - Finally, for the Student Representatives, both Aniyah Downer (10<sup>th</sup> grader) and Dameila Hanson (11<sup>th</sup> grader) were nominated, and each received 5 votes.
- Once the voting was concluded, Principal Robinson turned the meeting back over to Mrs. Sanaullah.

### **SAF Meeting**

- The SAF meeting called to order at 3:46 p.m.
- Approval of May 2024 SAF minutes were the motion accepted by Mrs. Attah seconded by Mrs. Martin.
- Mrs. Sanaullah started the election process, clearly explaining the procedures and purpose of each role.
- The Election Results:
  - First, Ms. Lila Thropes was elected as the SAF Chair with 7 votes.
  - Next, the Vice Chair position did not have a nominee and was left open; the position was still open to fulfill.
  - Then, Ms. Denaira Reed was elected as the Recording Secretary, also with 7 votes.
- Thropes emphasized the importance of the School Advisory Forum, highlighting its role in empowering parents and stakeholders.
- Thropes encouraged families to use SAF as a platform for sharing their voices freely in shaping the school community.
- Thropes provided an overview of Central Advisory meetings and urged parents to attend to remain informed and engaged.
- Thropes clarified the differences between SAC and SAF:
  - SAF: Parent-run, staff members do not have voting rights.
  - SAC: Inclusive of staff, parents, and all stakeholders with voting participation.
- Thropes stressed the importance of parents joining SAF meetings to vote and make their voices heard.
- Parents were reminded to check the school and district websites for important updates.
- Questions were raised about schedule changes and how these concerns are being addressed. Principal Robinson asked parents to be patient as they are leveling classes
- Introduction of a new Task Force for Parent Concerns, directly connected to the District, to improve communication and responsiveness.
