	<p>PM2 Data was shared in ELA and Math. Mrs. Harvey-Spence spoke about interventions that are taking place for fragile student support so that they can make growth in each academic area. ELA data shows that there is an overall proficiency of 39%, and this is on the same path as i-Ready. In math, the overall score was 29% but based on past trends that score will surpass because students were not taught all the standards prior to taking the assessment. Data shows that we are on track to make the gains needed to attain the targeted goal of an "A".</p> <p>The goal is being achieved through weekly classroom walk-throughs, common planning, and strategies that are implemented and revised as we work toward improving our school grade.</p> <p>Ms. Elias, a parent/volunteer, encouraged other parents to volunteer in the school to see the day-to-day work that the teachers put into moving the students.</p>

<p>Principal's Report</p>	<p>The School Choice window will be closed tomorrow. School choice is for families that would like to move to schools other than their boundary school.</p> <p>The railing replacement in the 900 building is now complete, with little interruption to classrooms.</p> <p>We are now in crunch time for academic instruction in preparing for the end of year testing. This will determine which students meet promotion criteria. Ms. Haynes asked parents for support as we go through crunch time.</p> <p>Next week, we will be presenting to the Instructional Review team to showcase what we are doing daily to meet the academic needs of our students.</p> <p>Awards assemblies will be coming up next week.</p> <p>Ms. Haynes made a request for funds to purchase headphones for testing. A motion made by Migna Elias, to use prior year school recognition funds in the amount of \$2,226.00 for 600 headphones. Motion was seconded by Aldett Francis. After a brief discussion, the motion passed unanimously.</p> <p>Ms. Haynes also made a request for 50 headsets with microphones. A motion was made by Kathia Lopez-Santana, to use \$518.00 from the prior year's school recognition fund, for 50 headsets with microphones for WIDA testing and work with Varsity Tutor sessions. Motion was seconded by Migna Elias. After a brief discussion, the motion passed unanimously.</p> <p>Ms. Haynes also made a request for house shirts for students using money from the Accountability Fund. Discussion was held about how the shirts can be paid for next year if there is no funding, A motion was made by Migna Elias to use money not exceeding \$7000, from the Accountability Fund for house shirts for the students in March. Motion was seconded by Maria Contreras/Kathia Lopez Santana. After a brief discussion, the motion passed unanimously.</p>





