Call to Order/Welcome /Introductions	The meeting was called to order at 8:35 a.m. Mrs. Harvey-Spence welcomed everyone to the last meeting of the school year and made formal introductions.

New Business	
School Improvement Plan Monitoring and Stakeholder Feedback	<p>Mr. Starks reviewed the School Improvement goals that had been established and provided updates on student progress. He shared that each area is currently demonstrating growth. Based on the preliminary data from the PM3 assessments, increases are being seen across all areas.</p> <p>The goal of increasing the percentage of K-2 students scoring at or above Level 3 in reading on the F.A.S.T. assessment by at least 12 percentage points, as measured by the STAR FAST ELA Assessment, was achieved.</p> <p>While there was an increase in the percentage of students in Grades 3-5 scoring at or above Level 3 in reading on the F.A.S.T. assessment, the targeted 10% increase, as measured by the FAST ELA Assessment, was not achieved.</p> <p>Our math goal for the lowest 25% of students is to increase their learning gains to 65% on the F.A.S.T. PM3 Assessment was not achieved. Although there was growth in this area, with learning gains reaching 57%, the established target was not met.</p>



Principal's Report	<p>Mrs. Haynes thanked the parents for their commitment and continued support of the school. She then presented a projected budget for the 2026–2027 school year, noting that the final budget may increase or decrease depending on student enrollment during the October FTE survey in the fall.</p> <p>She explained that upcoming budget cuts will result in several changes for the new school year. Staffing reductions will include the loss of one position in grades K, 1, 2, 4, and 5. In addition, the school will move from four specials classes to three. Mrs. Haynes shared that the school budget is based on student enrollment and provided a breakdown of each area, including how the reductions may impact staffing. The school will also lose one general clerk position and one custodian position. Staff members affected by these changes will be reassigned to positions for which they are qualified or certified.</p> <p>The floor was then opened for questions and comments. One parent expressed concern about how the budget cuts might affect the intervention groups implemented this year, in which students received additional support in both math and reading through pull-out services. The parent shared that these interventions greatly contributed to student growth and success.</p>
