

School Advisory Council (SAC) Meeting Minutes**

Date: February 26, 2026

Time: 5:35 p.m. – 6:54 p.m.

Attendance: 17

Call to Order

- The SAC meeting was called to order at **5:35 p.m.** by Ms. Laborde and Ms. O'Neal.

Review & Approval of January 2026 SAC Meeting Minutes

- Parents, staff, and attendees were provided with time to review the minutes from the previous meeting. Corrections were noted and made to all documents. Ms. Laborde reviewed the process for voting by the SAC committee. A quorum was established with **10 of 17 SAC members present (59%)**, allowing for voting to take place.
 - **Motion:** To approve the January 29, 2026, SAC meeting minutes
 - **Vote:** Approved
 - **Result:** Motion carried

Principal's Updates shared by Ms. O'Neal

- Celebrations, Athletics, and School Culture
 - **Honor Roll Assembly:** Appreciation was extended to the PTSA for providing student incentives.
 - **Pep Rally:** The school celebrated student athletes, the marching band, and the boys' basketball team advancing to the playoffs.
 - **Athletics Update:** Track season will begin soon, with tryouts facilitated by Ms. Beneby and Mr. Mauricin.
 - **Day of Service & Love (February 13):** Schoolwide service projects were completed across campus, creating a positive school climate.
 - **Student Celebrations:** Ice cream celebrations, Level Up shirts, trophies, medals, and other incentives were recognized as successful student motivators.
 - **Go Green Initiative:** A schoolwide "Go Green" celebration was discussed, incorporating school spirit activities and environmental awareness.
- Schoolwide Instructional Programs & Student Engagement
 - Ms. Foster shared instructional highlights connected to Garden to Table learning experiences. Students engaged in writing activities focused on questions, menus, labeling, and global food exploration. Instruction emphasized environmental responsibility through lessons on reducing food waste (reduce, reuse, recycle) and incorporated national recipes tied to Black History Month.
 - The importance of increasing **parent involvement** was discussed to better represent the diverse cultures within the school community. Parents and community members were encouraged to participate following completion of the district vetting process.
- Academic and Assessment Updates
 - Updates were provided on **Biology, Algebra, Math (Topic 11), and ELA Benchmark** assessments.
 - After school tutoring will begin for **Civics, Reading, 4th Grade, 6th Grade, and 7th Grade students.**
 - School performance data reflected growth from **57% to 64%**, demonstrating continued academic improvement.
- Safety, Discipline, and SESIR Report
 - SESIR data was reviewed:
 - **November:** Two incidents reported
 - **December:** Alcohol and physical attack incidents
 - **January:** Zero incidents reported
 - The administration shared that school safety data compares favorably with other districts. The effectiveness of the "**See Something, Say Something**" initiative was reinforced. Parents were reminded of the importance of monitoring student social media use.
 - Elementary behavior concerns were discussed, emphasizing early intervention and support. Middle School behavior was noted as strong, with students demonstrating positive school culture.
- Parent Allocation Funds
 - Reviewed Parent Allocation funds. Reviewed funds spent this year and explained to parents how funds can be used for students and for school. Reviewed the process of how funds must be spent and how to make proposals. There were no questions at this time.

- School Accountability Funds
 - The current School Accountability Fund balance is 19,884.96.
 - Proposed expenditures included:
 - **\$5,000 for student incentives**
 - Instructional resources such as:
 - UFLI Phonics (K-2)
 - Wordly Wise (Vocabulary)
 - Civics instructional resources
 - Progress Learning for Science (Middle School proposal for next year)
 - **Motions and Voting**
 - **Motion 1: To approve \$5,000 from School Accountability Funds for student incentives**
 - **Vote:** 10/17 members in favor (59%)
 - **Result:** Motion carried
 - **Motion 2: To approve the Parent and Family Engagement Plan and Title 1 Compact**

Title 1 Updates: Parent Family Engagement Plan & Title 1 Compact & Parent Survey Results

- The Parent Family Engagement Plan and Title 1 Compact were shared with parents. Ms. Laborde discussed the purpose of the PFEP and the Title 1 Compact. Parents were shown where they can access the plan. The Title 1 Parent survey results indicate high satisfaction with school communication. Parents reviewed the plans and were asked if they had any suggestions or changes for the plans. The suggestion was made to change in the PFEP the Literacy Night to January to align with the state. Parents suggested including a recommendation in the parent section that caregivers monitor their child's social media usage to be added to the Title 1 Compact and changes were made during the meeting.
 - **Vote:** 10/17 members in favor
 - **Result:** Motion carried

SIP (School Improvement Plan) with Title I Addendum

- Mrs. Laborde provided updates on:
 - School website rebranding and access to SIP documents
 - MTSS processes, including progress monitoring every 5-6 weeks and whole child supports
 - SEL, attendance, and family engagement plans
- The school maintains **Title I eligibility at 79.7%**, supporting instructional positions and family engagement initiatives. Proposed events included a Literacy Night, Science Night, and adjusted Curriculum Night scheduling. Parents were provided with time to review the plan and were asked if they had any suggestions or changes to the plan. Parents were invited to review and provide feedback. No changes were needed.
