Meeting Details

Date: March 25, 2026

Location: Media Center, Fairway Elementary School

Attendance

Of the 19 committee members, 9 were present at the meeting. As a result, the quorum necessary for official voting or approvals was not achieved. Accordingly, the meeting was held for informational purposes only.

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 2:45 PM by Ms. Harris. She made the motion to begin at 2.45 pm, Ms. Good 1st and Ms. Chambers 2nd.

Approval of Minutes

Ms. Harris read the January and February meeting minutes. The minutes were not approved due to quorum not being met.

Title 1 Parent Family Engagement Plan 2025 -2026 Review and Feedback 2026-2027

Ms. Good presented and discussed the Title 1 Family Engagement Plan, explaining that we host Title 1 nights (also called academic nights) and PTO nights. She outlined how the funds are allocated. Ms. Good suggested we might need to organize another kindergarten round up in May 2026. She also asked the committee for recommendations for the 2026-2027 school year.

A suggestion was made regarding replacing Barnes and Noble night with a local library night.

Title 1 Parent Compact Plan 2025 -2026 Review and Feedback 2026- 2027

Ms. Good reviewed the parent compact plan. Ms. Good asked the committee if we have any recommendations or feedback for the 2026-2027 school year and none was provided.

A review was conducted regarding the parental involvement funds totaling \$3,341. Historically, these funds have been allocated for student agendas. Ms. Good invited the committee to provide suggestions or feedback concerning the use of these funds for parental involvement; however, no comments were offered.

A review of the Title 1 funds in the amount of \$12,551. Ms. Good asked the committee if we had any suggestions or feedback for the Title 1 funds and no feedback was received.

School Improvement Plans Monitoring and Gather Stakeholder Feedback

We are currently in the editing stages of the plan. The document will be submitted to committee members for review since it contains extensive content.

Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) Customer Survey 2026 - 2027

Ms. Good notified parents that a minimum response rate of 20% is required for survey completion. Staff members have been encouraging parents to participate in the survey during dismissal periods.

Accountability Funds and Balance Request

K-2 teachers have \$1000 available for classroom materials and submitted an invoice to the school advisory council. The council could not approve the funds because a quorum was not met.





Ms. Harris made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 3: 15 PM. The motion carried out unanimously.
