- I. **Welcome.....Mrs. De La O**
  - A) Meeting called to order at 3:42 PM.
  
- II. **Pledge of Allegiance.....Ms. Goman**
  
- III. **December 2025 Minutes Corrections/Approval.....Ms. De La O**
  - A) Minutes from the December meeting were corrected, then approved
  - B) Motion to accept – Mr. Trimas, 2<sup>nd</sup> – Ms. Silber
  
- IV. **Testing Updates.....Mr. Espinosa**
  - A) PM2 will take place on 1/8/26 for all 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students. (Other students remaining in 1<sup>st</sup> period class, reporting directions on Canvas) \*\*\*Testing is adaptive.
  
- V. **Department Updates.....Open**
  - A) **Social Studies** [Mr. Curry] BSA held at end of quarter 2, attendance posed biggest challenge, 40 students did not take exam (10%), 58.5 % schoolwide proficiency for quarter 2 (increase from 2024-2025) compared to 62.1% district proficiency, concerned that quarter 3 BSA is only open for four days
  - B) **ELA** [Ms. Goman] 21 seniors in need of reading requirement, 109 juniors in need of reading requirement, upcoming ACT testing in March
  - C) **Math** [Ms. Pierce] 23 seniors in need of math requirement
  - D) **Counseling** [Mrs. Reid] Course selection starting on 1/20/26, will be run through English (9<sup>th</sup>), World History (10<sup>th</sup>), and US History (11<sup>th</sup>) classes, two weeks for make-up sessions
  - E) **Attendance Concerns** [Mr. Most] Average daily attendance for the first semester was 88.42%, total excused absences: 9th grade - 938 absences, 10th grade -1236, 11th grade - 1368, 12th grade -1680

**VI. School Improvement Plan Monitoring.....Ms. Fletcher**

- A) Top 5 Behavior Infractions (cell phones - 839, tardiness, disobedience/insubordination - 167, class cut/skipping - 244, inciting a disturbance), 1648 total referrals

**VII. New Waiver SAC Vote.....Ms. Fletcher**

- A) Waiver process is still ongoing, next steps (review sample ballot, share with teachers, teachers who do not attend voting – count as “no”, students would be dismissed 3 hours early for four additional days during 2627 school year
- B) Motion to accept ballot – Mr. Trimas, 2<sup>nd</sup> – Ms. Silber (unanimously approved, 10 voting members, will proceed with staff voting)

**VIII. New Business.....Ms. Goman**

- A) Logistical concern [*Ms. Singer*], difficult entry to campus for non-staff members at 3:30 for SAC meetings, suggestion – times of operation posted on gates to assist with entering campus

**IX. Principal’s Report.....Mr. Most**

- A) **SESIR Report** December – 166 referrals (72 cell phones, 24 tardies, 24 disobedience/insubordination, and more serious incidents e.g. firearm on campus before Christmas break, 3 – vaping , 4 - tobacco, 2 – fighting) 300 average referrals per month, continuing disconnect to reconnect policy
- B) **Schools Report** Upcoming PM2 testing, industry certification testing – end of February/early March, SAT for juniors, ACT for seniors
