## **6. State of Sparta Report - Ms. Fletcher**

- Reviewed 2024–2025 performance data and goals for the 2025–2026 school year.

### **Data Summary:**

- School grade decreased by 3 points.
- Math learning gains decreased by 1%.
- Social Studies achievement decreased by 1%.
- ELA achievement increased by 3%.
- ELA learning gains increased by 1%.
- School remains the only “C” high school in Broward County.
- The State of Florida has raised school grade requirements.
- Assessment Summary: School needs to make up 26 points to raise the grade to a “B.”

### **Challenges:**

- Common planning for all teachers was not possible due to additional teaching periods.
- Professional Study Days proposal did not pass last school year.

### **Goals for 2025–2026:**

- Increase ELA learning gains from 44% to 51%.
- Increase Math learning gains from 53% to 60%.
- Theme for the year: *“Rise Up, Refocus, Reclaim.”*
