- I. Welcome.....Mrs. De La O**
- A) Meeting called to order at 3:39 PM by Mrs. De La O.
- II. Pledge of Allegiance.....Ms. Goman**
- III. October 2025 Minutes Corrections/Approval.....Mrs. De La O**
- A) Minutes from the October meeting were not accepted, as a quorum was not met. We reviewed them only. This was tabled until our next SAC meeting on December 2nd.
- IV. Testing Updates.....Ms. Fletcher**
- A) ACT testing was held today (63 seniors still need the reading requirements, 36 seniors still need the math requirements).
- B) December 12, 2025 – December 19, 2025 (Math retakes, ELA retakes, and FCLE) will take place. A boot camp will be available for 11th- and 12th-grade students who need to meet reading graduation requirements on December 2nd through December 4th to prepare students for testing.
- C) ELA – PM2 for all 9th & 10th grade students (31% proficiency).
- D) Broward Standard Assessment given for quarter 1 (Biology/US History/Math),
***currently at 63% proficiency for Biology, which is the district average.
- V. Department Updates.....Ms. Fletcher**
- A) SIP - Review of MTSS Action Plan and MTSS process.
- B) MTSS goals: SMART goal - Increase in performance from 31% to 39% by the end of the school year, using data from PM3 (ELA & Math), 15% decrease in overall referrals
- VI. Media Center Collection Development Plan.....Ms. Fletcher**

- A) Current total number of books – 10,657
- B) 40% of books classified as diverse titles (37% of titles support SEL)
- C) Procedures reviewed - Library Bill of Rights, opt-out procedure, and budget
- D) Goals – increase in the overall number of books per student, increase the total collection of books to 15,000

- A) SESIR (October 2025) – 18 incidents of drug possession, four physical attacks, one case of sexual harassment, two cases of nicotine, one threat, and one fight
- B) Vape strategy – every 15 minutes, restrooms are inspected (looking for vandalism and drugs).
- C) PTSO rep suggestion - parent meetings later in the evening to review procedures for drugs
- D) Student tip - Halo Smart Technology (detection of THC in restrooms, devices installed in walls and roof)
