SAC Minutes - February 4, 2026

---

**Call to Order:** Meeting was called to order by Ms. Philippe at 5:40pm. and attendance was taken at the meeting.

### **New Business:**

- Ms. Philippe welcomed and thanked all the attendees for attending the February and outlined the meeting agenda.

### **School Updates**

- Ms. Philippe provides updates on the Honor Roll assembly scheduled for February 4 and 5 has been rescheduled to February 11 and 12 due to cold weather.
- Field Day is scheduled for February 13, and volunteers are needed, especially those cleared by Broward County Public Schools.
- Ms. Philippe emphasized the need for volunteers for Field Day. If you have not yet received district clearance, the process is straightforward. You may either visit the school's front office to speak with staff members—Ms. Williams, Coach, or Ms. Carmen—or access the volunteer link online. Once approved and verified, the school would appreciate any assistance you may provide.
- Early release is scheduled for February 13, with dismissal at 12 noon. If students are in CBC, they will remain on campus. If they are van riders, they will be picked up with their respected van transportation at their designated time.
- No school on February 16 for Presidents Day. School will resume February 17
- Black History Month and Spirit Week will be held from February 23 to 27. Flyers will be distributed.
- Ms. Philippe concluded the new business with information on Reading for the Record, which will take place on February 26, where volunteers will come out to our school to read to our students.
- Ms. Philippe provided an update on the School Recognition fund ballot results.
  - Proposal one received the highest number of votes, which allocated funds to instructional coaches to collaborate with teachers in identifying necessary materials and supplies for students in the upcoming school year. This proposal was favored by 40 individuals, representing 47% of the vote. Proposal two accounted for 6%, with 130 votes, and proposal three garnered 11%.
- Ms. Philippe introduced Miss Allen to present updates on the school's construction.

### **2026-2027 School-Level Parent and Family Engagement Plan (PFEP)**

- A comprehensive review of the 2025-2026 Parent and Family Engagement Plan was presented by Ms. Curry.
  - A copy of the PFEP was projected for everyone to view. Multiple languages copies were provided in Spanish, Portuguese and Haitian Creole parents. Parents and other SAC members were given the opportunity to participate in the development, evaluation, and revisions of the 2026-2027 School-Level Parent and Family Engagement Plan (PFEP). The parents and other SAC members offered no input and agreed with all the components of the 2026-2027 PFEP. The 2026-2027 was approved and adopted by parents and other SAC members.

### **2026-2027 School Parent Compact**

- Ms. Curry shared the 2025-2026 School Parent Compact template with parents and SAC members. She reviewed and discussed the content in all sections (school, parent, and student responsibilities).
- Parents and SAC members were given the opportunity to provide input regarding the development of Markham's 2026-2027 School-Parent Compact. The parents and other SAC members offered no input and agreed to accept the components of the 2026-2027 School-Parent Compact.

### **Review of the Parent and Family Engagement Survey Results**

- A detailed review of the 2025-2026 Annual Title I School and Family Engagement Survey was presented by Ms. Curry.
- The survey results were projected for parents to view. She discussed every survey question and shared the results, identifying our many strengths and a few areas in which C. Robert Markham can show improvement.
- Ms. Curry also gave parents and SAC members the opportunity to ask questions, state concerns, or suggestions, but there were no questions or concerns, nor suggestions from parent and SAC members regarding the survey results. 2025-2026 School Improvement Plan and Title I Addendum
- Ms. Philippe shared the current School Improvement Plan (SIP) with Title I Addendum. Ms. Philippe reviewed and explained each section and informed parents and SAM members that the plan is available on Markham's website for further review.

### **School Construction Update presented by Ms. Allen**

- Recap was provided by Ms. Junoisier Allen
  - The foundation is currently being removed, after which underground work—such as plumbing, electrical, and water systems—will commence. Upon completion of these phases, a new two-story facility will be constructed, featuring state-of-the-art art and music rooms, a cafeteria, an auditorium, and a combined cafeteria/auditorium space. All classes

presently housed in portable units will transition into the new building. Significant construction activities are scheduled throughout the summer, with comprehensive renovations anticipated to be finalized by early 2027.

### **School Updates for the month of January**

- Ms. Allen provided an update on school events, emphasizing Markham Elementary's celebrations involving students. These events are designed to foster academic achievement and motivate family engagement.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade students went on a field trip to Flamingo Gardens.
- Kindergarten roundup was on January 13
- Literacy Week was celebrated on January 26-30
- 1<sup>st</sup> Grade students went on a SEAS Field Trip
- January 28 was literacy night and kindergarten Roundup.

### **Assessments**

- Ms. Allen shared that there were several assessments during January: Assessments for our ELL students – WIDA, iReady, Diagnostics AP2, Science MOY.
- On January 26, we launched the Varsity Tutors program, an enrichment initiative designed for students in Grades 4 and 5. This program is delivered by a live tutor, and students engage using their computers and microphones to interact with the instructor and collaboratively solve mathematics problems.
- After-school tutoring is scheduled to commence in February. Our target start date is February 16. Students will receive permission slips this week in order to participate in the program.
- February, we have 2<sup>nd</sup> grade field trip to the Museum of Discovery and Science.
- 4<sup>th</sup> Grade field trip to Parker Playhouse on February 9
- Other highlights included information on Interim reports to be issued on February 6.
- Tornado drill is scheduled for February 11.
- Ms. Allen concluded by presenting the findings from previous assessments. In both ELA and mathematics, 28% of our students are performing at early, mid, or above grade level. This indicates that between 20% and 28% of students typically master a full year's curriculum standards for their respective grade levels. Currently, 28% have achieved this milestone.

**Accountability Funds:**

- Ms. Philippe wrapped up the meeting with information about the Accountability Funds.
- There is an allocation of \$2,740 designated for instructional materials, including workflow and curriculum resources. All purchases must be approved by SAC prior to acquisition through the school. Proposals will be presented at the SAC meeting for consideration, and a committee vote will determine fund release. Upon approval, Ms. Allen will oversee the distribution of these funds.
- Ms. Philippe and Ms. Allen clarified that any unused funds for the 2025-2026 school year will be carried over to the 2026-2027 school year.
- After confirming that neither Sessir nor the PTA had updates, Ms. Philippe adjourned the meeting.

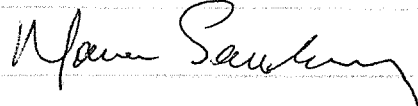

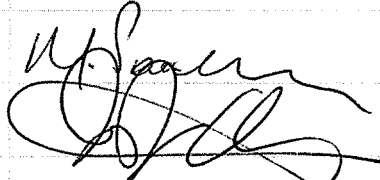
