SAC Minutes - April 16, 2026

Call to Order: Meeting was called to order by Ms. Philippe at 5:08pm. and attendance was taken at the meeting.

New Business:

- Ms. Philippe welcomed and began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and provided updates on various campus events.

School Updates

- The school is celebrating Child Abuse Prevention Week and Autism Awareness Week, with specific themed days for each. Flyers have been sent home to parents.
- Take Your Child to Work Day is scheduled for April 23, and forms for this event are being collected.
- Fourth-quarter interim reports will be issued on April 28, and testing windows will open on April 29 and extend through May 29.
- Testing and Assessment Schedule
 - The STAR Renaissance assessments for grades K – 2nd is scheduled from April 28 to April 30, with makeup dates on May 1.
 - Kindergarten through second grade will have their STAR Renaissance
 - ELA assessments from May 5 to May 7, with a makeup date on May 9.
 - Fifth graders will take their STAR Renaissance science test from May 12 to May 14, with a makeup day on May 26 or 29.
 - Third, fourth, and fifth graders will take their ELA fast assessment from May 15 to May 18, with a makeup date from May 26 to May 29.

Proposals for new SAC members

- Ms. Philippe stated that we need a proposal for certain staff members.
- Ms. Philippe also reported that she had contacted several staff members who expressed interest in joining the SAC. Additionally, Ms. Philippe remarked on the need for a paraprofessional to assume Ms. Castro's role. Ms. Scott and Ms. Jackson were suggested, given their consistent attendance at SAC meetings.
- Ms. Allen proposed Ms. Curry for consideration; however, Ms. Philippe had previously reached out to her, and Ms. Curry was somewhat hesitant to commit.
- Ms. Philippe indicated that voting on the members must be conducted using the designated forms. As these forms were not available at today's meeting, the vote was postponed.

School Construction Update

- Ms. Allen reported that no construction activities took place during the month of April.
- Ms. Allen indicated she is awaiting a response from the foreman regarding the anticipated resumption of construction. She also noted that both the Monday and Wednesday meetings were cancelled.
- In response to an inquiry about the expected completion date for the building, Ms. Allen stated that the proposed timeline is set for 2027.

Accountability Funds (Currently pending)

- Ms. Allen discussed the status of accountability funds
- The accountability funds are currently awaiting final approval. At our last meeting, we held a vote regarding the allocation of these funds, as outlined in the agenda. The decision was made to utilize the funds for purposes that benefit both the students and the school.
- Additionally, the recognition fund was discussed, with plans to use it for purchasing items intended for student and school needs.
- Ms. Allen went on further and noted that once the grants department provides final approval, the funds will be distributed according to the decisions made during the meeting.

- Ms. Chapman does not have any new information to share from the recent PTA meeting. However, she noted that the PTA is currently organizing a fundraiser outside the school.





