SAC/SAF Minutes - May 20, 2026

Call to Order: Meeting was called to order by Ms. Philippe at 5:08pm. and attendance was taken at the meeting.

4th Quarter Award Ceremony

- Fourth-quarter Award ceremony and moving up ceremony for grades pre-k through 5th grade
 - May 29th, 2026 (Friday)
 - 2nd Grade at 8:30am
 - Pre-K- VPK at 9:00am (will be held individually in each teacher's class)
 - Kindergarten at 9:30am (will be held in the media center if weather temperatures are unbearable)
 - June 1st, 2026 (Monday)
 - 4th Grade at 8:30am
 - 3rd Grade at 9:00am
 - 5th Grade at 6:00pm (Promotion Ceremony at Ely High School Auditorium)
- **Testing and Assessment Schedule**

- Ms. Philippe provided all attendees with an update on district testing status per grade level.
- Ms. Philippe informed everyone that students in grade kindergarten through 2nd grade have completed both ELA and Math STAR/Renaissance assessments. Students who missed testing days will be tested during the makeup window of May 26- May 29
- Ms. Philippe also informed attendees that students in grades 3rd through 5th grade have completed their ELA and Math F.A.S.T assessments. Students who missed testing days will be tested during the makeup window of May 26- May 29
- Ms. Philippe informed attendees that 5th grade Science F.A.S.T was the final district assessment to be completed and is scheduled for May 27th and May 28th

Early Release Day/No School

- Ms. Philippe stated that May 22, 2026 (Friday) school will be dismissed at 12:00pm (noon) for students and May 25th 2026 school will be closed in observance of the Memorial Day holiday.

No Backpacks

- Ms. Philippe informed attendees that starting May 29th through June 3rd, 2026 students will not be allowed to bring backpacks to school. Lunch boxes and small personal hygiene bags are permitted but no large bags or backpacks are allowed.

School Construction Update

- Ms. Philippe introduced Ms. Allen to the attendees and informed them that she would be providing updates on the status of the school construction and information on the school budget for the 2026-2027 school year.
- Ms. Allen reported that no construction activities took place during the month of May.
- Ms. Allen stated that she was informed by the construction crew that during the first week of June the underground process of working on the plumbing will take place. This process will help alleviate the flooding and draining issue that we also have around campus when it rains.
- Ms. Allen also stated that this process will begin once students and staff are all of campus to ensure no disruption of the school learning environment.
- In response to an inquiry about the expected completion date for the building, Ms. Allen stated that the proposed timeline is set for 2027.

2026- 2027 School Budget

- Ms. Allen stated to the attendees that funds provided to schools within the district are all projected monies based on the FTE/enrollment of students. Which can affect the positions of individuals but not the individuals themselves.
- Ms. Allen stated that the district has projected the students count for C. Robert Markham elementary for the 2026-2027 school year at 458 students.

- Funding for C. Robert Markham Elementary for the year 2026-2027 is projected at \$1,955,290.00.

- Teachers \$1,276,170.00
- Support \$ 181,928.00
- Special \$ 474,955.00
- Idea \$ 22,240.00

Total Projection= \$1,955,290.00

- Ms. Allen informed attendees about the number of staff and educators that would be needed and required for each grade and department.
 - Pre-k and VPK: 4 Teachers
 - Kindergarten: 3 Teachers
 - 1st Grade: 3 Teachers
 - 2nd Grade: 3 Teachers
 - 3rd Grade: 4 Teachers
 - 4th Grade: 4 Teachers
 - 5th Grade: 4 Teachers
 - Specials: P.E. (Physical Education), Music, and Media Specialist (Certified Teacher is required). Computer Science was eliminated due to the lack of funding within the magnet department.
 - Administrative/Clerical: 1 Principal, 1 Assistant Principal, 1 Office Manager, 1 IMT (Informational Management Tech), 1 General Clerk, 2 ESE teacher assistant, 1 SRO (School Resource Officer), 2 Security Guards. The Media clerk position was eliminated due to the lack of funding within the district.
 - Support Staff: 1 Reading Coach, 1 Math Coach, 1 ESE Specialist, 1 Support Facilitator, 1 Resource Teacher, 1 Science Coach, and 1 Guidance Counselor
- Ms. Allen stated that the projection of the 2026-2027 budget is not an accurate amount. The budget may increase or decrease depending on the number of students that are enrolled.

Accountability Funds

- Ms. Allen discussed the status of accountability funds
- The accountability funds have been utilized for the 2025-2026 school year. Funds that were available were rolled over from previous school year 2019-2020. There are no available funds or roll-over funds for the 2026-2027 school year.

- Ms. Allen went on further and noted that the grants department provided final approval and funds the funds were distributed according to the decisions made during the meeting.

Sessir Updates

- No Sessir update for the month of May.

PTA

- Ms. Chapman was not in attendance but did provide information with Ms. Allen ahead of time to share with attendees at the meeting.
- Ms. Allen stated that the PTA will be hosting a sweet treat sale on May 22, 2026 with items starting off at \$1. Flyers and announcements have already been done via class dojo. The sweet treat sale will be done during student's specials time.
- Ms. Allen informed attendees to remind students of the sweet treat sale and to bring in enough funds for purchases

SAF Updates

- Ms. Philippe welcomed Ms Guillermo and thanked her for taking on the lead and charge by being our designated SAF chair for the 2025-2026 school year.
- Ms. Gulliermo welcomed everyone and thanked Ms. Philipe and Ms. Allen for having her as the designated SAF chair. Ms. Guillermo also suggested for attendees to possibly join SAC or SAF for the upcoming school year that they are informed about things going on around the school and district.


