SAC Minutes - October 1, 2025

Call to Order: Meeting was called to order by Ms. Philippe at 5:13pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited, and attendance was taken at the meeting

New Business:

Ms. Philippe welcomed parents, students and stakeholders to the second SAC meeting for the 2025-2026 school year.

School Updates/Construction

- Ms. Philippe introduced Ms. Allen to provide the construction updates.
- Ms. Allen started off by providing the SMART goal for the school year, which is to increase student proficiency in grades 2 through 5.
 - We will accomplish this through small group instructions, strengthen Tier 1 and Tier 2 students and provide interventions for students in Tier 3.
 - The academic priority is to deepen teacher understanding of the B.E.S.T. standards and effective instructional practices, target small group instructions in all grade levels, and use data for planning, instructions and interventions. Integrate academic vocabulary in the scores and increase the rigor and engagement in student learning.
 - Teachers have been participating in Professional development, as well as Professional Learning Community and Common Planning.
 - Instructional coaches continue to provide support in mentoring and co-teaching in the *coaching cycle*.
- Students just completed the FAST PM1 and iReady Diagnostics.

Construction Updates

- In building 1, demolition is scheduled for December 2025 as part of the ongoing facility improvement.
- Family engagement with strong family participation in special events, such as, Back-to-school Orientation, Open House, Dad: Take your Child to School Day, and Grand Parents Day. These events continue to strengthen our partnership between home and school.

PTA

The PTA members were not present and hopefully will be at the next meeting in November.

- Ms. Philippe shared a little on behalf of the PTA, that they are still working on trying to get parents to sign up for PTA. She reminded the attendees that registration is \$10, and that goes towards PTA doing things for the school, students, teachers, and also for the parents as well. In the past they have received grants but unfortunately, they were not going to be able to receive that this year because they are at the end of the 5-year grant term that was allotted.

SAF Updates

- SAF Chair was not present.
 - Ms. Philippe opened the floor for questions or concerns.

Open Floor/New Items for November SAC Meeting

- Ms. Jackson voiced her concerns about items on the agenda that was removed. Ms. Allen answered Ms. Jackson's query, by stating that an email went out to address the district's policy regarding the approval of the budget.
- The principal's job is to facilitate SAC operation to ensure that compliance of our By-Laws and Sunshine-Laws are followed. The principal supports and monitors the school improvement plan; Act as a liaison between SAC, the District and the family. In addition, ensure the district's policy are adhered to.
- The principal approves the SAC Agenda.
- To answer the query from Ms. Jackson's question, Ms. Allen stated that the principal manages the budget, and since the money (the A+ funds) was not released, it was not on the agenda because the money had to be approved first. The district approves the money to be spent.
- Ms. Allen went on to say that, as soon as that money (A+ Funds) is released, she will let it known so that we can address that.
- Any suggestions or recommendations to spend money, the principal has to approve the money being spent – not approve the vote.





