**SUBJECT: UPDATED POLICY FOR STUDENT WIRELESS DEVICE EXPECTATIONS**

Broward County Public Schools policy for all students requires that all wireless communication devices, including cell phones, laptops, headphones, and smartwatches, must remain powered off or in airplane mode throughout the school day, with a few minor exceptions.

**During the October 14, 2025, Regular School Board Meeting,** the Board voted to amend School Board Policy 5090 and **allow high school students to utilize their wireless devices during their assigned lunch period.** It is important to note that this change **does not apply** to passing time for class change or during instructional time. During these times, high school students may only use their devices under the direct supervision of a teacher/administrator, and solely for instructional purposes.

**SUBJECT: IN-SCHOOL FIELD TRIP/GUEST SPEAKER/CO-CURRICULAR EVENT/ACTIVITY/SUPPLEMENTAL PROGRAMS PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN AUTHORIZATION FORM**

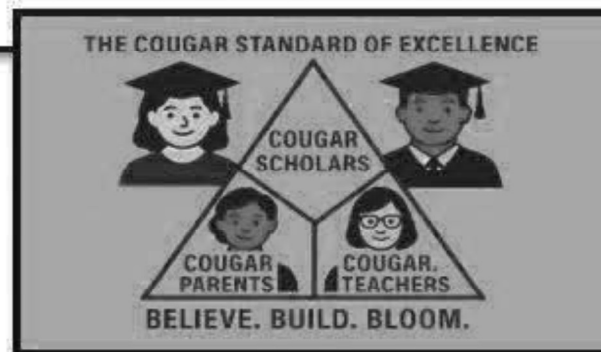
**Action:** All afterschool extracurricular and supplemental clubs, programs, and extended learning opportunities require a signed parent/legal guardian permission form prior to a student being permitted to attend. Additionally, all in-school field trips, on-campus co-curricular events, and activities require a signed parent/legal guardian permission form prior to a student being permitted to attend. The permission form must be completed in its entirety to include, at minimum, the following details:

- The nature of the event or activity.
- The date(s) and time(s) of the event or activity.
- Specific location(s) and type(s) of sponsors/guests at the event or activity.
- Method of student supervision provided, such as the anticipated number of chaperones.

A separate form, signed by a student's parent/legal guardian is required for each club, program, or activity and must be maintained by the club sponsor.

An attached form, initialed by a student's parent/legal guardian may be utilized for multiple events for an individual club (i.e., SGA, Band, etc.) or for multiple pre-planned school events (i.e., Stem Night, Read for the Record, etc.).

**Rationale:** Rule 6A-10.089, F.A.C. requires Districts to adopt procedures to fully inform parents of the details of events, activities, or supplemental programs. District procedures must require signed parent or guardian permission forms for events or activities. The Afterschool Extracurricular and Supplemental Program Parent/Legal Guardian Authorization Form serves to assist schools in compliance with this requirement.



## District-Wide Announcement

Beginning Monday, September 8, 2025, the following District-wide protocols will be in effect for all schools:

### **Athletic Practices**

- All athletic practices held on District campuses are closed to spectators.
- Only the following individuals are authorized to be present at practices:
  - District-Cleared Coaches
  - School and District personnel
  - Student-Athletes
- Family members, friends, and other visitors may not enter gyms, fields, or any practice areas during practice times.

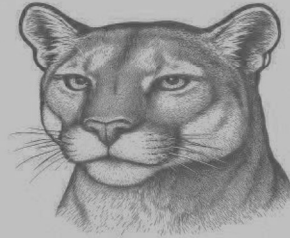

**SUBJECT: UPDATED POLICY FOR STUDENT WIRELESS DEVICE EXPECTATIONS**

Broward County Public Schools policy for all students requires that all wireless communication devices, including cell phones, laptops, headphones, and smartwatches, must remain powered off or in airplane mode throughout the school day, with a few minor exceptions.

**During the October 14, 2025, Regular School Board Meeting,** the Board voted to amend School Board Policy 5090 and **allow high school students to utilize their wireless devices during their assigned lunch period.** It is important to note that this change **does not apply** to passing time for class change or during instructional time. During these times, high school students may only use their devices under the direct supervision of a teacher/administrator, and solely for instructional purposes.

**SUBJECT: IN-SCHOOL FIELD TRIP/GUEST SPEAKER/CO-CURRICULAR EVENT/ACTIVITY/SUPPLEMENTAL PROGRAMS PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN AUTHORIZATION FORM**

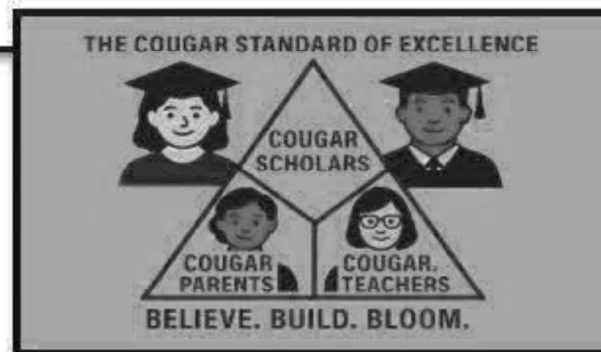
**Action:** All afterschool extracurricular and supplemental clubs, programs, and extended learning opportunities require a signed parent/legal guardian permission form prior to a student being permitted to attend. Additionally, all in-school field trips, on-campus co-curricular events, and activities require a signed parent/legal guardian permission form prior to a student being permitted to attend. The permission form must be completed in its entirety to include, at minimum, the following details:

- The nature of the event or activity.
- The date(s) and time(s) of the event or activity.
- Specific location(s) and type(s) of sponsors/guests at the event or activity.
- Method of student supervision provided, such as the anticipated number of chaperones.

A separate form, signed by a student's parent/legal guardian is required for each club, program, or activity and must be maintained by the club sponsor.

An attached form, initialed by a student's parent/legal guardian may be utilized for multiple events for an individual club (i.e., SGA, Band, etc.) or for multiple pre-planned school events (i.e., Stem Night, Read for the Record, etc.).

**Rationale:** Rule 6A-10.089, F.A.C. requires Districts to adopt procedures to fully inform parents of the details of events, activities, or supplemental programs. District procedures must require signed parent or guardian permission forms for events or activities. The Afterschool Extracurricular and Supplemental Program Parent/Legal Guardian Authorization Form serves to assist schools in compliance with this requirement.



## District-Wide Announcement

Beginning Monday, September 8, 2025, the following District-wide protocols will be in effect for all schools:

### **Athletic Practices**

- All athletic practices held on District campuses are closed to spectators.
- Only the following individuals are authorized to be present at practices:
  - District-Cleared Coaches

  - Student-Athletes
