Call to Order:

A meeting of the Boyd H. Anderson High School Advisory Council was held on 10/23/2025 SAC Chair Meagan Killinger called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm. Secretary Michael Soto recorded minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:

5:36 PM Chair Megan Killinger called the meeting to order following the Pledge of Allegiance. Members introduced themselves, including Annie Callaway, non-instructional representative (Guidance), and other SAC attendees.

Quorum not established (8 of 15 members required). A motion was made to defer all scheduled votes to the next meeting; motion carried by consensus.

- **District Update: Addressed Broward County budget reductions; no departmental restructuring expected. Enrollment Trends: District decline from 271,000 to 201,000 students.**
- **New Programs: Construction Program, Hilo Post-Secondary Partnership, JROTC Career Day, Government Day civic events.**
- **Academic Interventions: Reading intervention to target 7th-grade proficiency benchmark for FAST/PM tests. Advanced Academics: AP Capstone program launched; dual-enrollment participation increased to 80 families.**

6:00 PM SESIR Update was presented by Ms. Shelman:

- **Attendance and Hall-Sweep Initiatives were explained to the group.**
- **Goal: Increase instructional time and reduce tardiness.**
- **ID scanning and hall sweeps implemented. Immediate parent communication for missed classes.**

Mrs. Killinger Presented the Character Education Recognition:

- **October trait: Responsibility. Students recognized: Jeremiah Mayman, Kadian Birdie, Jerry Mighty. Student representative Raquel acknowledged for participation.**

Mrs. Killinger Conducted the Elections and Nominations:

- **Motion carried.**
