- Ms. Killinger reviewed each component of the plan.
- The plan was created based on school data. Attention was directed to page 3 of the document for a data breakdown.
- Ms. Killinger referenced the discipline matrix where behavior incidents can be clearly defined.
- Students of character initiative will be expanded.

- A suggestion was made by Dr. Andrade to display counselors in the main hallway.
- Ms. Hal-Haniff suggested posting rules in an interactive fashion.
- Discipline procedures were not adjusted.
- The plan includes implementing C.H.A.M.P.S.
- A parent wanted confirmation on C.H.A.M.P.S. on how to see it in practice.
- A parent acknowledged C.H.A.M.P.S. will be helpful articulating concerns.
- Ms. Callaway asked how implementation will be monitored.
- The district will lead the professional development.
- MTSS will monitor the implementation.
- Ms. Killinger paused for feedback from the group.
- Ms. Killinger reviewed the school's current tardy plan. She highlighted how rewards in that plan will parallel those in the behavior plan.
- The Cobra Cash section of the plan was reviewed.
- All staff will have access to this system.
