1. Abilities Awareness Night

- a. Thursday, January 29, 2026 at The Quest Center 6 to 8 PM.
- b. Design to connect parents with community organizations that offer services and support to individuals with special needs.

2. The Entrepreneur Education and Development Center

- a. Irvon Plummer-Founder and CEO 754-610-6765 www.teedc.org
- b. Create opportunities for Young people to be equipped with skills to think an act like entrepreneurs, manage their finances responsibly, and build successful futures.
- c. Hands-on learning, mentorship, and real-world business experiences
- d. Students develop the confidence, leadership, and tools they need to create their own paths and make a lasting impact on their communities.
- e. Core Programs
 - i. NexGen Builder: an entrepreneurship experience where students create business ideas, design branding, and earn real income.
 - ii. Shop with a Boss: a holiday mentoring experience pairing youth with community leaders to teach smart spending and financial discipline.
 - iii. BeyondCon Young Entrepreneur Conference: a conference that expose the students to professionals, speakers in real world career paths. For students ages 13-19.
- f. Additional Youth Programs
 - i. **Move and Play Learning Lab**: an interactive, movement-based learning experience come binding creativity, teamwork and physical activity.
 - ii. **Lemonade Stand Jam**: a fun, youth lead business activity where students create a lemonade brand, design signage, and learn simple sales skills.
- g. Nextup 18/18: Students can be nominated if some thinks they are a champion and under the age of 18. Trying to find 18 students under the age of 18.

3. Food & Nutrition Services Dept.

- a. Restricted by USDA guidelines.
- b. Created focus groups with students for input and feedback on food quality and options.
- c. There is a menu committee meeting that happens 3 to 4 times yearly to discuss menu options.
- d. Each student is allowed to get two fruits and two vegetables per meal if they are hungry. This follows under the USDA guidelines.
- e. No artificial dyes in the foods.
- f. All beef products are 100% beef


- g.** No additives
- h.** Vegetarian options are available for every meal.
- i.** Expanding food options for cultural diversity
- j.** 100% whole wheat
- k.** No trans fats
- l.** Antibiotic free chicken and egg products
- m.** For students to be able to check out in line, they need to choose one fruit or vegetable on their tray.
- n.** Special diets: currently offer gluten-free only for celiac disease and needs to be in medically necessary indicated by a doctor's note.
- o.** Share table
 - i.** Allows students to donate their unwanted unopened food to a table where other students can take additional food.
 - ii.** Staff operating the share table is required to complete a training.
 - iii.** Table located next to the register.
 - iv.** Students need to donate their unwanted food before they leave the register area.
 - v.** Perishable food needs to remain at the allowed temperatures.
