

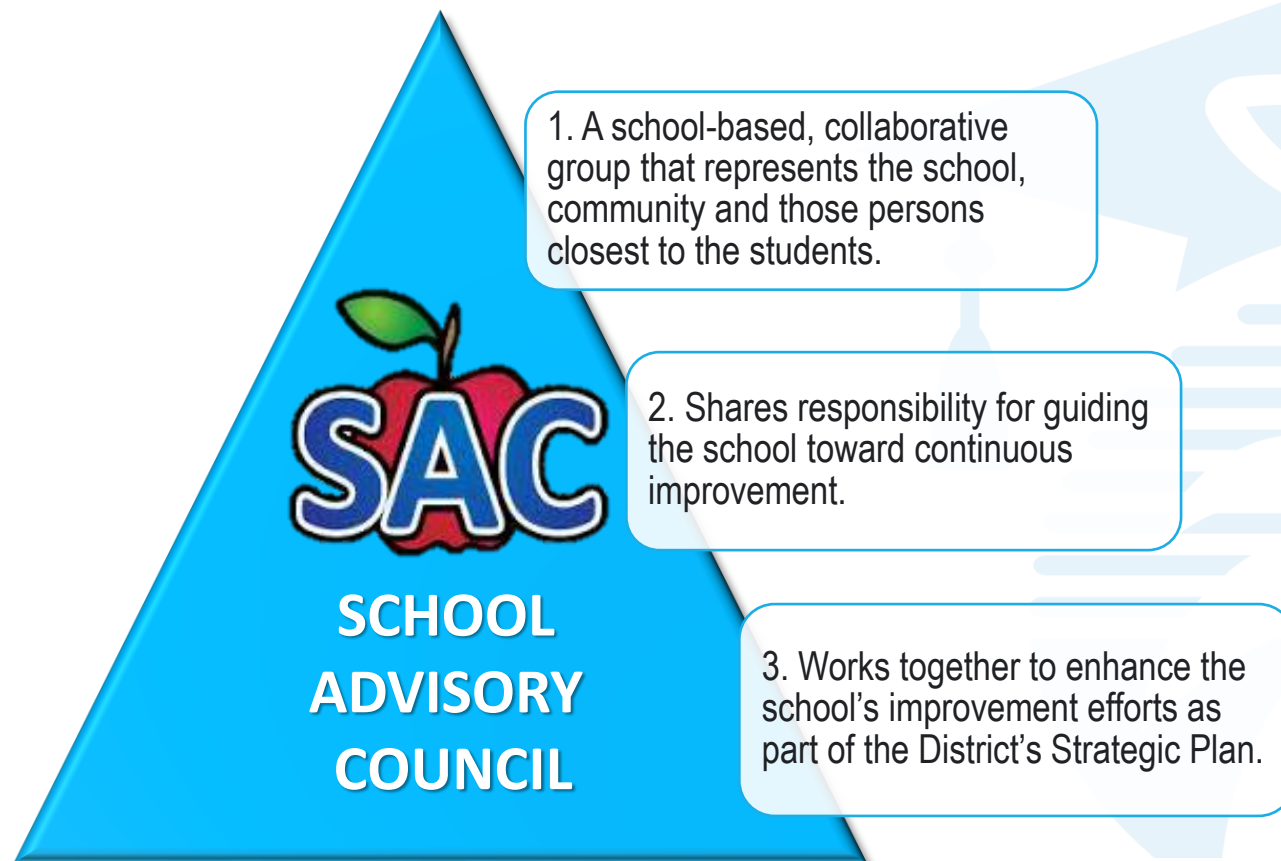

What is SAC?

SBBC Policy 1403 Governs SAC

Each school is required to establish a School Advisory Council (SAC) that is representative of the population served by the school. Per state statute (S1001.452) a majority of the SAC members cannot be employees of the Broward County Public Schools. Members must be elected by their peer groups (teachers by teachers, parents by parents, etc.).





Purpose of SAC



Collaborate on the development and monitor the progress of the annual School Improvement Plan (SIP).



Allocate Accountability Funds to support the SIP goals and objectives.



Take part in the school's annual budget and plan (F.S.C. 1001.452).





How Does SAC Monitor the SIP?



Guiding Questions:

- What are we trying to accomplish?
- What changes can be made towards improvement?
- How will we know that the change has made an improvement?

Monitoring Process:

- **Review** the Areas of Focus and SMART Goals
- **Data Review**
 - Areas of increase?
 - Areas of concern?
- **Review Action Steps/Strategies/Interventions**
 - What's working?
 - What's not working?
- **Adjustments/Shifts**
 - Strategies/Interventions?
 - Action steps?

The School Advisory Council (SAC) meeting was **called to order at 8:00 AM by Ms. Blair Gray** in the Media Center.

Purpose of SAC Review

Ms. Blair Gray reviewed the purpose and role of SAC, including:

- Collaborating on the development and monitoring of the **School Improvement Plan (SIP)**

- Participating in school planning and budgeting in accordance with **F.S. 1001.452** and **SBBC Policy 1403**

SIP Monitoring

School Goal Reviewed:

- By **June 2026**, **51% of students in grades 3–5** will score at or above **Level 3 on the FAST ELA assessment**, an increase from a **49% baseline** in the 2024–2025 school year.

The council reviewed data, instructional strategies, and monitoring processes to track progress toward this goal.
