The School Improvement Plan (SIP) is an on-going document used to identify the needs of the school and improve those needs at school level.

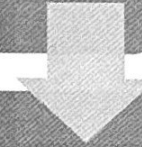


The school improvement team uses the SIP as a guide in developing a plan that addresses student achievement needs, monitoring the implementation of the plan, and to revise it when appropriate.

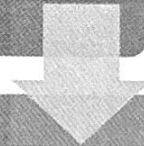


# School Improvement Plan

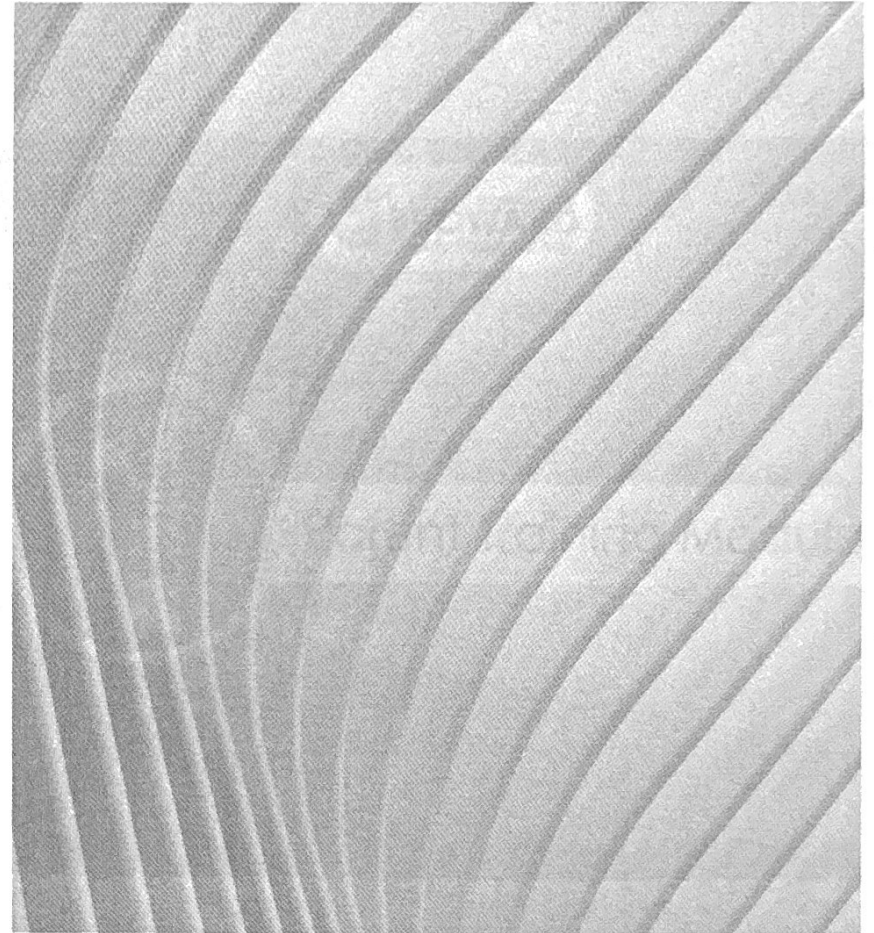

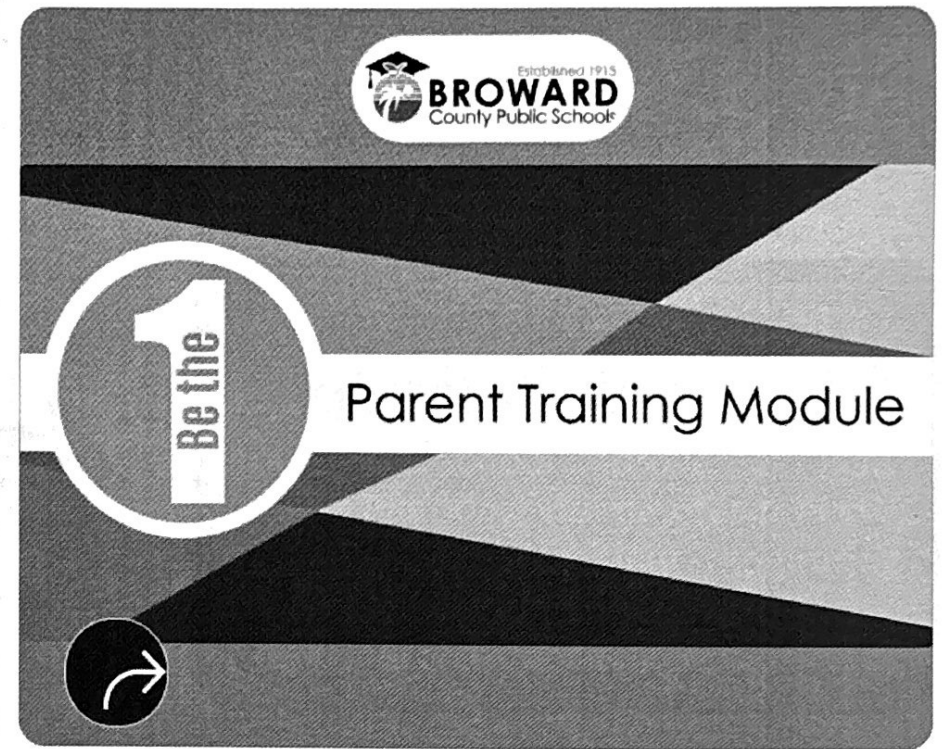

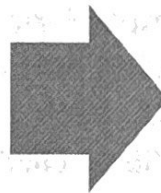
