## 6. Open Discussion

- A parent queried about aftercare procedures especially as it pertains to attendance. They recommend that they be given warnings before being told that their children will be asked to discontinue. The Boys and Girls Club representative clarified that this letter may have been guidelines for maintaining funding rather than mandates.
- Kudos to the volunteers from the Boys and Girls Club who volunteered at the Black History Showcase.
- The Kudos also to the tutoring team.

## 7. SAF Updates

Mrs. Sanchez gave a report on discussions during the last SAF meeting

- The meeting was focused on security and safety. Issues discussed included:
  - ✓ The Centigix device that teachers wear was discussed.
  - ✓ The single point of entry was discussed. The RAPTOR system
  - ✓ Currently, school security is 94% staffed.
  - ✓ Registered sex offender still has their parental rights.
  - ✓ Doors that face the exterior fencing need to be locked so do classroom doors.
