Minutes

1. Welcome Mrs. Sainvil

A motion was made by Mr. Pigan to start the meeting at 5:05 pm

2. Approval of SAC Meeting Minutes Mrs. Sainvil
a. December 17, 2025

Ms. Flynt moved to approve the minutes after they were read.

3. Principal Updates Dr. Kushner

Our current enrolment is 1217 meaning we have had a few students move away. Dr Kushner mentioned that when he asked at least five parents why they were moving and the parents said it was a matter of affordability.

- a. Accountability Funds

The balance is \$5,827 in rollover funds from previous years.

\$15,300 is the balance on the budget.

- b. SESIR Data

Through September 2025 - 14 total events

A parent queried about a recent social media message that Mrs. Meinsen had sent a Parent Link about. Dr. Kushner said there was an investigation and the report was found not to be credible.

4. School Improvement Plan Mrs. Perez

- There is a current vacancy as a custodian was let go and now the position needs to be filled.
- There are no expected vacancies for faculty for the 2026-2027 school year. No anticipated change in programs. The current budget is not allowing for new programs.
- There has been a change in the date for the end of the year school trip. It is now planned for May 19, 2026.

- The parents were asked for their input on the 2026-2027 School Improvement Plan. The parents asked about:
 - a. the inclusion of more clubs. Some of the clubs that we currently have are First Priority and National Junior Honors Society. Dr. Kushner replied that as long as there are stipends and sponsors then clubs will be offered.
 - b. Extra Learning Opportunities (ELOs) and when they may possibly begin in the upcoming school year. This will be dependent on the amount of funds received and allocated for ELOs in the budget.

5. Title One updates

Dr. Morris

- a. 2025-2026 Parent and Family Engagement Survey
The survey was displayed and discussed. It was noted that respondents agreed or strongly agreed with how Apollo communicates with them.
2025-2026 Parent and Family Engagement Plan was reviewed by the attendees who asked about the attendance for some of the events. Dr. Morris said that the events that had student performance were always better attended. The parents said then try to keep student performance in each event.
- b. 2026-2027 Parent and Family Engagement Plan
The attendees were presented with the 2026-2027 plan, they read through it and when asked if there is any input, no input was given, therefore the plan was adopted.
- c. 2025-2026 School-Parent compact
The attendees read through the 2025-2026 compact and asked about why there were two different items for teacher conferences. Dr. Morris mentioned that one item was specific to school parent compact.
- d. 2026-2027 School-Parent Compact
The attendees read through the 2026-2027 compact and asked for their input. No one had an input. The compact was accepted.




