I. Welcome & Introductions

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by SAC Chairperson **Kerene Nelson**. Attendance was recorded (see sign-in sheet).

II. Approval of Minutes

The January SAC meeting minutes were reviewed. No changes were requested and the minutes were approved unanimously.

III. Principal Updates

Principal **Ms. Rumble-Wise** shared updates regarding school progress as the school year continues. During recent classroom walkthroughs, administration observed strong instructional practices and purposeful student engagement across grade levels.

The principal emphasized the importance of **clear instruction, consistent expectations for students, and collaboration among staff** as key instructional priorities for the remainder of the school year.

Teachers continue working collaboratively through **Professional Learning Communities (PLCs)** and grade-level planning sessions to ensure high-quality instruction and alignment to standards.

The school also participated in **Read for the Record**, promoting literacy and student engagement through reading activities across grade levels.

Additionally, Royal Palm Elementary continues collaborating with schools in the **Boyd Anderson Innovation Zone**, and staff were encouraged to participate in the upcoming zone showcase event highlighting instructional practices.
















XII. Adjournment
