Website

There is a new user friendly and organized website. 235 school sites, 90 departments and 80,000 pages were updated. It's part of the marketing and branding initiative to attract families. The district added an enroll now feature to their website as well.

Schools will now be able to update their school news and calendar. Outlook is now being used, allowing calendar information to be entered once without the need for manual reentry. While this streamlines some processes, the information still needs to be uploaded, regularly monitored and updated. It remains a significant task that continues to require dedicated and ongoing effort.

School Safety and Student Services

BCPS cares has launched. Parents can communicate with schools. On the Broward Schools Website there is a yellow button to click if you have a school related concern. This BCPS cares form goes to the school Principal and the Regional office. However, if there's a concern it's best to contact the teacher first, then the principal and then BCPS cares. Principals may not have had the opportunity to show they care. It will be shared internally, and the response rate will be streamlined. If a concern is made to the School Board first it will take longer to address. Most issues can be resolved at the school level.

Some concerns that have arisen at various schools are the lack of full-time nurses, schools charging school groups to use the facilities and the lack of intercom systems in portables, however Cooper City High School has not had these issues. A parent mentioned a full-time nurse is provided when a school has at least one student with a medical need.

Budget

There will be a Budget Training seminar held on October 29, 2025, via Teams that will discuss how the district is funded, how a school is funded, things you can advocate for before the budget is done, and more.
