

- Attendance- Can support whether it's health issues, housing issues, transportation issues we know that we are able to assist. attendance every day arrival in dismissal so arrival we just make sure again that you're here dropping off on time utilizing we do not have supervision before 7:30 you know it's always something of concern that we work with our local police officers of having people in place before them but I do not have in my budget to have anybody out there before 7:30 so I'm freezing to have anybody out there before 7:30 so although we are in within a community of beautiful community things happen and I do not want anything happening to our scholars before an after school but when there's no supervision so please make sure that you are dropping off at 7:30 you are utilizing following our procedures with dropping off kids at arrival dismissal arrival please
- Starting The Morning Show and then we go straight into instruction a lot of times for the most part I would say about a good percentage of our school 97% of our school starts with ELA first with reading and we're missing 5 to 10 minutes that adds up to hours within a week so being here on time, it's very crucial for our kids.
- Need authorization- Random people coming to pick up the kids, and I cannot take them. I cannot take the word of a student that I know this person with this person to release them.
- You must show your ID at the active camera before you are admitted into campus OK so please make sure if you pass somebody just picking up your child. Please make sure that you're going to do what you had that even if you are signing in bringing into sign in or sign out your child that you have a license with you or my





- If they see something say something that is one of the biggest protective that protected that we can have protective factors that we can have on preventing something so knock on wood we have not had any serious incident on campus and our student students are very well trained as something doesn't seem right or somebody said something to say something. We have what we call a BTM team here of BTM as a behavioral threat management team and anytime Student Is saying something that's concerning or showing concern concerning on behaviors than that BTM team does a thorough investigation of the situation to ensure that the threat is minimize, and if there is a represented what we are next course of action on making sure that that child and bystanders are victims are protected so if you see something you say something, nothing is too small or too silly
- Another thing that's new this year, can you see our staff walking around with badges? It's another safety that we have that if there is any support that is needed on campus anybody can lock down the school staff member is able to lockdown school if they see threat an infinite threat on campus if there's any type of medical alert that they also have been trained on how to socialize this device to our safety, we were able to locate another layer of Security on our campus as well so we have just concluded our BTRPM our progress monitoring assessment for the school year and we have them three times a year. we call a PM 1 PM 2 PM three as well as our eye ready as well.
- Reach out to your teachers your child's teacher to say listen. I would like to have you get some updates on how my child is doing and what that plan of action is OK, and they should also be reaching out to you as well so please feel free to contact your teachers as we finish those assessments. They are also available for you to view on focus as well. OK you're able to get live. All the bottom of your children's assessment. It should be focused on where you could see how they performed and again I highly suggest that you contact your child's teacher to set up those conferences so that you have they can go in more in detail with you of what to understand.
