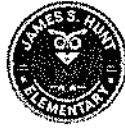

A. Area of Focus: Mid-Year Reflection

The leadership team and the SAC CoChairs are currently reviewing data to determine whether action steps (the school-wide implementation of the UFLI curriculum, a deliberate focus on phonics in the primary grades and increased emphasis on data driven instruction) have yielded positive results. VI. Principal's Report (Vaughn)

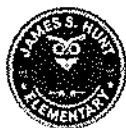
Ms. Vaughn addressed the possibility of using accountability funds to purchase curriculum for students, but since quorum was not met, the item was tabled for the February meeting.

A. Community Business Spotlight




