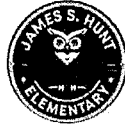

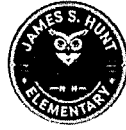

Meeting called to order at 5:50pm

II. Introduction/Attendance (Amodu)

9 of the 20 voting members were present and in attendance. Quorum was not met. This was an information-only meeting.

V. SIP Monitoring & Stakeholder Feedback (Gerstenfeld)

A. Area of Focus: Multi-Tiered System of Support Plan

Ms. Gerstenfeld the School's Multi-Tiered System of Support Plan, which entails the Positive Behavior Intervention System (PBIS) and the Response to Intervention Process (RtI). RtI seeks to identify students who need help in Reading, Math, or Social and Emotional skills. At Hunt Elementary, a team comprising the school psychologist, the English Language Learner Teacher, the guidance counselors and other stake holders meet weekly and use data to evaluate the whole child to determine how to support students who are not making progress. Ms. Gerstenfeld outlined the different Tiers of Support, with Tier One consisting of what is available to all students, Tier Two consisting of targeted support and Tier 3 consisting of more intensive, targeted support. Ms. Gerstenfeld also reviewed the school's efforts to offer teachers more professional development that would allow them to use data to identify struggling student, such as a weekly iReady Workshop held at the school.

VI. Principal's Report

A. (Parent Involvement Fund Allocation) (Amodu)

Mr. Amodu reviewed James S. Hunt Elementary's use of the Title I Parent Involvement Allocation Funds. Hunt Elementary received \$5407.00 in Parent Involvement Allocation funds, of which \$3570 were used to purchase agendas and folders for students. We have \$600.00 for refreshments that have not been released. The school paid for two parents to attend parent seminars at \$40 each.

Mr. Amodu asked if anyone had any suggestions for how parental allocation money should be used next year. Ms. Mathew suggested that the school purchase agendas and folders for students for the upcoming school year. Ms. Purificato suggested a more proactive use of refreshments for parent and community events, such as School Advisory Council Meeting to increase attendance

B. Acaletics- \$1,400 (Vaughn)

This is a curriculum the school would like to purchase for math with accountability funds. The purchase requires SAC approval.

C. PM3 Carnival: \$2,000

The school would like to use the accountability funds for a PM3 carnival. The purchase requires SAC approval.
