- I. Introduction/Approve Minutes from November 2025 Meeting *Motion to approve minutes by Marimer Fernandez and seconded by Pamela Perry.*
- II. Review of Accountability and Recognition Funds- Michele Arguelles
 - Accountability Funds: \$10, 381.00
 - o *Last meeting it was \$11,169 after paying Mrs. Moronta*
 - o *Will request to use Accountability funds again in January after our FAST PM2 data for Extended Learning Opportunities (ELO) Camps to pay teachers to do small groups for reading, math, and science before or after school.*
 - Recognition Funds: \$7,645.70
- III. Recognition Funds/A+ Funds & Proposals- Michele Arguelles & Stephanie Saban
 - Drafting of Proposals for this school year:*
 - *Proposal #1 from last school year: Historically, 100% of the A+ funds will be equally distributed amongst permanent staff based on the percentage the work week, who worked a minimum of 151 days in the 2024-2025 school year.*
 - o *Removed by vote of 9 out of 10 voting members in SAC committee.*
 - *Proposal #2 added by Diana Flynn: 70% of the funds will be equally distributed amongst permanent staff who worked at Coral Cove Elementary based on the percentage of the work week, for a minimum of 151 days in the 2024-2025 school year. The remaining 30% of the funds will be distributed equally to the staff who remained at Coral Cove Academy of the Arts for the 2025-2026 school year, based on their work week.*

Pamela Perry seconded the motion.
9 out of 10 voted in favor.*

*Marimer Fernandez made a motion to make the ballot proposal #2 and None of the Above. Pamela Perry seconded the motion.
9 out of 10 voted in favor.*

*Official final proposals presented to the staff will be:
- 70% of the funds will be equally distributed amongst permanent staff who worked at Coral Cove Elementary based on the percentage of the work week, for a minimum of 151 days in the 2024-2025 school year. The remaining 30% of the funds will be distributed equally to the staff who remained at Coral Cove Academy of the Arts for the 2025-2026 school year, based on their work week.*



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 - Recognition Funds: \$7,645.70
- III. ELO Camps
 - *We just completed our 2nd round of FAST Testing and will use the FAST-Testing monitor student data with a school goal of at least 70% proficiency and 70% learning gains by the end of the school year.*
 - *Since we transitioned to a combination school, we now need an increase of our school-wide data points to maintain our school grade from at least 62% to 65%.*
 - *Learning Gains are for students who scored a Level 3 or Level 4 and need to score at least 1 point higher this school year. Students who scored a Level 5 just need to maintain Level 5.*
 - *Motion to approve by Marimer Fernandez and seconded by Indira Rubi to allocate the Accountability Funds to fund Extended Learning Opportunity (ELO) Camps, open to every teacher at \$50 per hour with targeted students using our PM2 F.A.S.T Testing Data to improve their reading and math proficiency and learning gains that impact our school grade.*
- IV. Principal's Updates- Stephanie Saban
 - *We are fully staffed in all of our general education classrooms.*
 - *We are still short two teachers in our ASD classrooms and have already reached out to the district about this.*
 - *Mrs. Saban and Mr. Figueroa have already conferenced with every family in our 3rd Kindergarten classroom.*

 - b. Middle School Transition Updates
 - *Glades is projected not to close next school year, so we projected to not get 8th graders next year and now our district boundary meetings at the end of January won't impact our school.*
 - *Panther Run Elementary, Palm Cove Elementary, and Sunshine Elementary are projected to be closed and consolidated.*

- Upcoming 6th Grade Showcase for our middle school programs will be on January 20th @ 6pm with all the 6th grade teachers.
- Last Robotics Competition will be in January and our Robotics team came in 2nd out of 9 schools at their December Robotics Competition.
- As our Middle School grows, we will be able to fund more support staff for the upcoming school year.
- Recently we got our Cambridge plaque for our school since we are a Cambridge school with Cambridge classes.
