 - School Assessment Data for the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (F.A.S.T.) Test
 - ◆ Mock FAST Testing
 - Students completed a trial run on a practice test to see how they would perform or what they need help with before they complete the End of the Year Assessments.
 - Geometry has completed this task with an 91% and Algebra at 89% predicted proficiency.
 - Physical Science and 7th grade GEARS has a 41% proficiency prediction.
 - Civics has a 72% rate of predicted proficiency
 - Biology has a 96% proficiency prediction.
 - Reading MAP Testing – March 23rd – March 27th
 - Upcoming FAST Test
 - ELA Writing Test – March 31st
 - ◆ It does not count this year.
 - We currently have less than 30 days until testing begins.
